## Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden

"I thought we played one exceptional quarter -- the third. They bopped up pretty good in the first half. They tackled, blocked and hit better than we did. The real difference was that we had more maturity and better skilled players. The fourth quarter was about as shoddy as an FSU team can play. I told Frank (Beamer) not to change a thing in his program. He's headed in the right direction.

'I had thought that we had peaked against South Carolina and that would carry us through the rest of our games, but I guess we're just a one-peaker.

"I scolded tham pretty good at halftime and told them I thought we were being out-played, but because our running game was working, I didn't feel it was necessary to change anything.

(about number of penalties in 4th quarter) "I was upset with the way we played. but I was also upset with our coaching. We didn't conform like we should have and that's a coaching problem.

(on the bowl situation) "I'm really not too concerned about it. All we can do is play our best and hope we get put in a situation to play for the national championship."

## Virginia Tech Head Coach Frank Beamer

"It was a rough third quarter for us. Field position made the difference. When you're backed up like we were, it limits the things you can do offensively. We never could seem to get out of the hole and our punting gamedidn't help us much either.

"Florida State is a great football team. I don't know if I'm ready to say they're the best we have played, both FSU and West Virginia are top five teams. Florida State does have the best receivers and maybe that gives them the edge. Many times tonight, we had the Florida State receivers well-covered and they just out-leaped us and made great plays. The FSU running game is so good too, and it's a combination of the two that makes them so tough to defense.

"I am proud of the effort that our football team gave. We did a lot of things well in the first half. But we do not do anough things well right now to beat a team as talented as Florida State. But we're going to get there. We've made progress and I think we can be a very good football team next season.
