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Notes on Tonight's Game

With 324 yards passing in the first half, Peter Tom Willis passed his previous career high of 301 yards (set last week against LSU), He passed that mark with :36 left in the first half.

LeRoy Butler became the first player to intercept two passes in a game since Dedrick Dodge did it last year. Dodge accomplished the feat against Tulane in 1988.

Freshman Amp Lee's 88 yard pass reception and touchdown ties him for the fifth longest touchdown play in FSU history.

On the first three times Amp Lee touched the ball, he scored twice, on a 6 yard run and an 88 yard pass reception.

Florida State broke the following Tulane opponents' records:

Most Yards Passing (Individual): Peter Tom Willis, 324 breaks record set by John Reaves of Florida in 1969 (297).

Longest Touchdown Pass: (Weldon to Lee for 88 yards breaks record of 81 yard TD pass from Clark to Wright of Houston, 1968.

by FSU breaks record of 354 by LSU in 1979. Most Passing Yards (Team):

Most TD Passes (Team): 5 by FSU breaks record of 4 shared by Louisville (1987), Maryland (1973) and Virginia (1968)

The last time Florida State passed for over 400 yards in a game was in 1982 against South Carolina (437).

Peter Tom Willis has 1,136 yards passing so far this season.

Quotes from FSU Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

"We played well in all facets of the game. Our kicking game was better and our defense continued to improve. We got hot throwing and catching the ball and that made us tough. The big thing is we improved and th-at's the key this year. We must improve every week."

"They ran an eight man front and they do a good job of disguising it. Plus they blitzed which forced us to the air. Peter Tom did another magnificent job. He read everything well and got the ball to the open man. Casey was unbelievable. One of those nights where everything turned to gold.

"Our plans were to run more. But they blitzed more than teams had against us all year. Defense is playing better. They got good work against a very good passing team. The interceptions were good. LeRoy Butler set the momentum. He was acvery dominant The defense set up a lot of scores for the offense.and that's figure tonight. what you need to win. "

Quotes from Tulane Head Coach Greg Davis:

"Well you know I'm extremely disappointed. You can't give up the amount of big plays early in the ball game to a team like Florida Sate. We didn't give our selves a chance early in the ball game, we fumbled on fourth down and short and Florida State's a good football team, but they're not that much better than us. I was encouraged by- some things I saw. Encouraged by the effort right to the end the guys played hard and that's encouraging. I thought that we ran the ball well. We played many backs. I was not pleased wi-th the way-we protected the passer and we made some mistakes that we can't make. We had some great situations to make

"It's a 60 minute ball game and it's designed to be played for 60 minutes. I can't worry about what Coach Bowden does, I have to woprry about Greg Davis. Deron wasn;;t as sharp as he was the first three ball games. We didn't protect him as well as we did in the first three ball games.
