FLORIDA STATE NOTES & QUOTES

**WR Ronald Lewis has caught a pass in 23 consecutive games with his catches today.

**Two blocked punts today were FSU's first of the year. Florida State has now blocked 51 punts under Head Coach Bobby Bowden, and 65 kicks. Two blocks in a game ties the Florida State record.

**Peter Tom Willis' 338 yards passing today is his third 300+ passing game of 1989. That ties the FSU record for most 300-yard passing games in a season, held by Gary Huff (1971) and Kim Hammond (1967).

**Willis now has 2,854 career passing yards, moving him into ninth place on FSU career charts. His 1,687 yards passing in six games this year rank ninth on the single season passing list. He needs 27 yards to pass the 1988 season total of Seminole starter Chip Ferguson (1,714).

**Willis had the best passing yardage day of his career with 338 yards. His previous best was 324 yards against Tulane three weeks ago.

FSU HEAD COACH BOBBY BOWDEN:

"Going into the game, we truly felt Virginia Tech was as good as anybody on our schedule. They had a hard time-reaching the same emotional level they were on last week. The thing that concerns me is that we are just bent to a pulp. We got a lot of knicks today.

"Peter Tom has just surpassed anything I could have expected from him. He just keeps doing it week after week. He was definitely a key today and that was against a defense that was one of the best in the country.

"LeRoy Butler was also a key for us defensively. He's just playing great. He almost finished it off there at the end with a great interception.

"I thought the blocked punts helped out the team. Last year we had five blocked punts in the first six games. This year, we hadn't had any going into today. I'm glad to see that part of our game has returned.

"Like I said, now we've got Ruth and Gehrig the next two weeks and we have got to continue to play well or we'll get left behind."

COACH FRANK BEAMER, VIRGINIA TECH

"I said before the game that Florida State is one of the five best teams in the country and nothing happened out there today to change my opinion. I will say this though. We helped FSU be a great football team today. I don't know if it was our coaching or the way we played, but on offense, we were in wrong sets and had the wrong reads all day. We didn't give ourselves a chance. As well as we played last week at West Virginia, we went the opposite way and played very poorly.

"The Florida State offense is just terrific. They make you defend the whole field and we did it poorly. I still think we have an outstanding defense, but today we did not do things fundamentally well. I don't think it was a question of speed. We just had poor fundamentals.

"Willis certainly is a great quarterback and he has great receivers. It would be difficult to stop them when you are playing well. It's impossible when you are playing poorly.

"Give all the credit to Florida State. We got beaten by a great team. I don't know if Florida State can work its way back up the top five with two losses. But I'll tell you this--the top five is where they belong.

"We have to regroup and get ready for East Carolina on the road. I think we will come back and give a much better performance. I still think we have a good football team."
