Florida State quarterback Peter Tom Willis became the first QB in FSU history to pass for over 300 yards in a game four times in a season. Willis' 300 yard games this year: LSU (301), Tulane (324), Virginia Tech (338) and South Carolina (362). Gary Huff (1971) and Kim Hammond (1967) had held the record along with Willis with three 300-yard passing games.

Willis' 362 yards were a career high.

His three touchdown passes today give him 24 in his career to move into a tie with Kelly Lowrey for eighth place on FSU career charts.

LeRoy Butler picked up his seventh interception of the year in the waning moments of the game. That gives him sole possession of third place on the Florida State single season INT list. He had been tied with nine others. He needs one more INT this season to tie for the single season record, held by Curt Campbell (1951) and Monk Bonasorte (1979), who had eight.

Today's attendance of 61,852 was the seventh largest crowd in Seminole history. This season, FSU has recorded five of its top 10 crowds of all-time. Those numbers and their place on the FSU charts: 1. Auburn (62,711) 3. Miami (62,602) 6. Clemson (61,897) 7. South Carolina (62,852) 9. Tulane (61,613)

Peter Tom Willis has completed 168 of 283 passes this season. 168 completions ranks fourth on the FSU single season list.

The FSU defense held its opponentato two touchdowns or less for the sixth straight game.

FLORIDA STATE HEAD COACH BOBBY BOWDEN

"We played good football against a good football team. South Carolina never gave up, they kept fighting and they were well-coached. I thought they were extremely well-prepared. Our defense played real well. We really only allowed the one long touchdown and a field goal. Our offense was sharp. Peter Tom was sharp, but we dropped a lot of passes. I'm very happy with our performance. We had a grueling October and if we survive November, good things could happen. The end of the season will tell just where Peter Tom fits in among all-time quarterbacks, but he's got to be way up there. Not just his ability, but his leadership and poise. We protected much better. Of course, we played against two of the nation's best the last two weeks (Miami and Auburn). South Carolina runs a very sound defense and they blitz just enough to throw us off. Wayne McDuffie called all the plays today. I didn't wear a headset at all. I told him if we take the first drive and score, you can call the rest. That's the first time in a while I haven't worn a headset, but the day will come. I thought our offensive staff did a tremendous job."

SOUTH CAROLINA HEAD COACH SPARKY WOODS

"Let me congratulate Florida State. They have a great football team and a great program. They are big and strong...just an excellent team...I'm proud of our football team. I thought we played hard and gave effort...Dickie (DeMasi) played hard, and under the circumstances, he did well. I thought we played hard on defense...I'm proud of our team from the standpoint that we battled after losing our quarterback last week. We should be a better football team after this game. We need to get our guys healthy (Dingle, especially) and learn from the film and make improvement from our mistakes...Peter Tom Willis is an excellent quarterback. I'll brag on everyone of their receivers. They are an impressive group...Pat Turner will learn (from playing quarterback today) and pick things up as he goes along...We had field position problems much of the afternoon...I told our team to concentrate on playing hard every down and I thought they did."
