Florida State Notes & Quotes

Peter Tom Willis became the top single season passer in FSU history tonight. His season stats read: 210 completions in 345 attempts for 3,124 yards, nine interceptions and 20 touchdowns. He becomes the first FSU quarterback to pass for over 3,000 yards in a single season. He now holds the Florida State single season records for completions (210), passing yardage (3,124) and total offense (3,004).

Willis also had his sixth 300+ yard passing day of the season with 319 today. His 300 yard performances this year have come against LSU (301), Tulane (324), Virginia Tech (338), South Carolina (362), Memphis State (482) and Florida (319).

Willis finishes his career third on the career passing yardage chart with 4,291, trailing only Gary Huff and Bill Cappleman. He's also third on the career pass completions list with 304.

Florida State finishes the 1980s with a record of 86-30-3.

Bobby Bowden evened his record against Florida at 7-7 with tonight's win. There are now only five teams against who Bowden has a less than .500 mark.

FSU has defeated Florida three straight times, and two consecutive at Florida Field. ~~XXXXXX~~

Ronald Lewis had one catch for nine yards to stretch his consecutive game reception streak to 27 games.

FSU Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

"We didn't look as good tonight as we should have. A whole lot of that was Florida's fault. They just didn't quite have the steps.

"Gary Darnell and his staff did a better job preparing their team than we did preparing ours. I just think they were extremely well-coached and well-prepared. "Those penalties come from having guys who have played together all of their lives. It reminded me of a bunch of kids down on a sandlot fighting and pushing.

"PT and Dexter Carter made play after play. Those were huge drives in the second half, the kind of drives that can make or break your season.

"I was very surprised at Florida's quickness. They were so quick we couldn't protect our passer. The running game became very important tonight, it really ate up the clock.

"I'm not sure this series is really swinging our way. Last year we beat them 52-17 and this year we barely beat them. I give credit to the way they were prepared.

"Our defense struggled. Odell went out early and Hayes wasn't at full strength."
