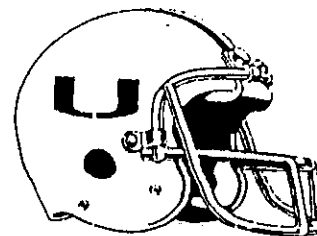

FLORIDA STATE NOTES

*** FSU senior wide receiver Lawrence Dawsey's 13 catches for 160 yards was the fifth-best single game receiving performance in FSU history (13 catches). No one in FSU history has caught as many passes in a game since Kent Gaydos snagged 13 passes vs. Houston in 1969.

*** Dawsey's day also gives him 96 catches for 1,566 yards in his career to move him past Fred Biletnikoff on the FSU career lists for both catches and receiving yardage. He now ranks eighth on the career reception list and ninth in receiving yards.

*** Dawsey extended his consecutive game receiving streak to 26 games with today's effort. He has caught at least one pass in every FSU game since the Clemson game of 1988.

*** Brad Johnson's 26 completions today marked a career high for the junior quarterback.

*** Senior tight end Dave Roberts' eight catches was also a career high. He finished with eight catches for 82 yards.

FSU HEAD COACH BOBBY BOWDEN:

"We lost this game in the first half. I can't believe the lack of poise we showed early. We played so much better in the second half, I thought we were gonna pull a 'Miami' of '87. Dennis (Erickson) did a lot better job of preparing his team than I did. We just kept putting ourselves in a hole. You can't start every drive first and 20. Dawsey really kept us in the game. I've never seen a wide receiver do that. I've seen quarterbacks, runners and defensive players. But that's the first wide receiver I've seen do that. To be honest, the game was lost up front. Their offensive line against our defensive line. We've got to get a lot tougher. Our next opponent will be just as tough as this one. We didn't hit much this week in practice because we had so many injuries. You can't beat Miami when you practice like that. The defense was playing good early, but the offense just couldn't do anything. We really got it together on offense in the second half. I don't think we punted one time. We could've won the stinking game. I really thought we could win, then they drove 80 yards and that pretty much wrapped it up."

CONLEY, McGUIRE SETS SINGLE-GAME RECORD:

Miami fullbacks Leonard Conley and Stephen McGuire broke their single-best rushing records today. Conley ran 16 times for 144 yards to top his previous best of 120 yards against Cincinnati in 1987. McGuire carried the ball 31 times for 176 yards today, topping his previous record of 136 yards against East Carolina on Nov. 4, 1989. McGuire's total yardage placed him fourth on UM's record list for yardage in a single game, and his 31 rushes put him in a tie for fourth place on UM's single-game rushing attempts with former UM running backs Otis Anderson (31 vs. Boston College, 1976) and John Noppenberg (31 vs. Tampa, 1931).

TWO UM RUSHERS ~~combined~~ rush for over 300 yds combined:

Today was the first time since Miami's game against East Carolina on Nov. 4, 1989, that UM had two runners gain more than 100 yards rushing. Current UM running backs Stephen McGuire and Alex Johnson rushed for 111 yards and 136 yards, respectively, against the Pirates last year.

UM RUNNERS TOP 300 TOTAL YARDS:

Hurricane runners gained 334 yards today. The last time UM runners gained more than 300 yards rushing was on Oct. 24, 1987, against Cincinnati when UM gained 384 total yards rushing.

SECOND-LARGEST CROWD IN UM HISTORY:

Today's crowd of 80,396 was the second-largest home crowd in UM history. Last year's crowd for the Notre Dame-Miami game (81,634) was the largest.

This is the third straight home game with more than 70,000 fans, two of which exceeded 80,000. Miami's two home games this year have totaled 150,816. By contrast, the entire 1980 home schedule of five games drew a total of 120,007.

STEVE MC GUIRE: "We knew that if we could run the ball we would be successful. We concentrated during practice, on run first. The offensive line did a great job firing off the ball and it made it easy for us to hit the holes and drive the ball down the field. It was a great team win."
