- *** Amp Lee's three rushing touchdowns today give him 11 on the season and gave him sole possession of fourth place on the FSU single season rushing TDs list. He needs two more scores rushing this year to tie Greg Allen (1983) for third. Lee also has 14 career rushing TDs to rank sixth on the FSU career list. The sophomore is just one score away from Sammie Smith's fifth place total of 15.
- *** Lawrence Dawsey's third-quarter pass reception extended his consecutive pass-reception streak to 27 games. This does not include a pair of bowl games. Dawsey could tie Ron Sellers streak with catches in his last three games. (Sellers' record: 30 games)
- *** South Carolina's fourth-quarter touchdown was the first given up by Florida State in seven quarters. The last time an opponent scored a TD against the FSU defense was in the final period of the Auburn game.
- *** Florida State came close to having a pair of 100-yard rushers as Sean Jackson gained 115 and Amp Lee 94. The last time two Seminoles gained over 100-yards in a game was in 1987 against Florida when the duo of Sammie Smith (116) and Dexter Carter (111) achieved the feat.
- *** Florida State partially blocked a punt for the second time in as many games, resuming its strong tradition in that area of special teams play.

SOUTH CAROLINA VS. FLORIDA STATE -- NOV. 3, 1990 -- GAMECOCK GAME NOTES:

Wright Mitchell's 42 yard touchdown pass to freshman Mario Henry in the fourth period was the second TD pass of the season for Mitchell, a sophomore from Atlanta. Mitchell passed for a touchdown against East Carolina. That score went to Bralyn Bennett.

How's this for consistency? For the past four weeks, Gamecock freshman tailback Rob DeBoer has entered a game averaging 6.5 yards per rush for the season. Today, DeBoer carried the football 10 times. Hee gained 65 yards. For the season, DeBoer has 489 yards in 75 tries.

Mike Dingle's 13 yard first half pass to David Pitchko was the first career pass attempt for the Gamecock senior tailback.

South Carolina has lost three games in a row for the first time since 1985. Losses to The Citadel, N. C. State and Florida State drop the Gamecock record to 4-4. In 1985, South Carolina lost consecutive games to Michigan, Georgia and Pittsburgh ~~in~~ before rallying from a 2-3 start to finish with a 5-6 record.

Mario Henry's touch'down reception was the first career score for the Gamecock redshirt freshman from Mt. Laurel, N. J. It also was his first career pass reception.

COACH SPARKY WOODS' --- QUOTES

"Congratulations to Florida State, they have an excellent football team. They won every phase of the game. They have excellent weapons at every position. They challenged us at the corners and were successful.

"They were dominant at the line of scrimmage.

"We missed out on some opportunities early that I think would of made it a better football game. We missed two interceptions, they caught theirs and we didn't."

"Field position obviously hurt us throughout the game."

"We had a blocked punt that was disappointing." This is...

"This is a team that I thought we couldn't get behind on. In the second half they knocked us off the ball."

"This is a very disappointing loss."

"At times I think we got out "athleted", Florida State has a great football team.
