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#### FLORIDA STATE NOTES

- \*\*\*Florida State hit the 70-point mark for only the fourth time in school history today. The last time FSU scored 70-plus points was in a 73-14 win over Tulane in 1987.
- \*\*\*Florida State broke a record for most touchdowns in a game with 10 today. The previous record was nine vs. East Carolina (9/20/80) and vs. Memphis State (11/17/90).
- \*\*\*Florida State's seven rushing touchdowns today ties the FSU record for rushing TDs in a game, previously set vs. East Carolina 9/20/80.
- \*\*\*Cincinnati dressed 53 players for today's game, Florida State 93. Of the FSU players who dressed, 76 played.
- \*\*\*The 49=point defeat was the second-worst in Bearcat history. In 1928, Cincinnati lost to Ohio Wesleyan 71-0, marking the worst defeat.
- \*\*\*Terrell Buckley's 83-yard interception return gave him the FSU record for most yards on interceptions in a single season. Buckley currently has 219 yards on six INTs. OLD RECORD: 139, LeRoy Butler, 1989-.
- \*\*\*Buckley's interception return was the sixth-longest in FSU history.
- \*\*\*Amp Lee's two rushing touchdowns give him 13 for the season to tie him with- Greg Allen (1983) on the FSU single season list. Lee has eight rushing TDs in the last three games and 16 for his career.
- \*\*\*Every member of FSU's first and second-team backfield scored a rushing touchdown today.
- \*\*\*Lawrence Dawsey's seven catches for 141 yards extended his consecutive game pass-catching streak to 28 games, not in-cluding bowls. The 100-yard receiving day was the third of the season for Dawsey- and fifth of his career. Dawsey's season total of 53 catches is good enough for eighth on the single season catch list. He now has 15 career touchdown catches to rank eighth on the career list for FSU. Dawsey ranks fourth in career catches with 116 and sixth in receiving yards with 1,803.
- \*\*\*Marvin Jones gathered his first career intercep-tion and Sean Jackson scored his first career touchdown today.

#### FLORIDA STATE HEAD COACH BOBBY BOWDEN

"We really had them out-manned. They are a very young team, the youngest we've played this year. They reminded me of us in 19-76, don't forget, four years later, we were undefeated.

"I though-t the defense played well and Casey sure played well. We tried to get the ball to Dawsey early, but they finally caught onto that. We really shut it down in the second half. It wasn't that tough to do. We've got some guys completely capable of shutting a game down.

"The best part about this game was that our boys went out there and took charge from the beginning. You're afraid in a game like this you'll go out and play sloppy. A lot of teams have struggled against Cincinnati. I've watched all their films.

"I'll tell you what. Since the first quarter of the Miami game, we've been playing pretty darn good.

#### CINCINNATI HEAD COACH TIM MURPHY:

"We ran into a buzz saw today, to a team that offensively is much better than we are. They- pretty much did whatever they- wanted on offense, operating at will. I really do have to say, that despite getting our butts kicked, which we really did, we did some really positive things. We had our best offensive day in the two years our staff has been here against a team that hadn't allowed a touchdown against two SEC teams in the last two weeks.

'We did some really good things, we just had a hard time because of immaturity and injuries.

"Coach Bowden didn't run up the score. He's a high class coach, he wouldn't do that.
