

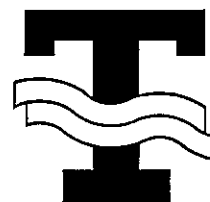

QUOTES FROM TULANE COACH GREG DAVIS:

"I thought we played hard. Obviously, we were not intimidated. Florida State is deserving of their No. 1 ranking. Not only are they a good team, but they are a good program.

"I thought we made great improvement from the first week (a 22-3 loss to Ole Miss last Saturday at home). If we hang in there and continue to improve, we'll be fine.

"I thought Bill Duncan played better. Steve Ballard caught the ball well and Mark Thornhill played well on defense.

"What I'm saying shouldn't be construed as being proud to lose. I was proud of our effort.

"We'll play a team in Mississippi State next week that's 2-0 and just knocked off a fine Texas club. We just need to improve as much between weeks two and three as we did between weeks one and two.

"Florida State is an outstanding team, and I thought we had to mix things up (offensively) against them. I didn't think we could throw it every snap or run it every snap. We moved the ball well early, then we got it going again in the fourth quarter.

"Florida State has great team speed, and as a result the ability to overcome mistakes quickly."

NOTES & QUOTES

*** Lonnie Johnson's 78-yard touchdown was the longest TD pass for Florida State since 1989 when Weldon and Amp Lee hooked up on an 88 yarder against Tulane.

*** You have to go back to 1978 to find the last Seminole to catch three TD passes in a game. Sam Platt caught three that season against Navy.

*** Amp Lee's 100-yard effort was the fourth of his career.

*** Tulane has now scored in 152 straight games, the fifth-longest active streak in Division I-A.

*** Casey Weldon has now completed 41 of 56 passes this year for a percentage of .732 with no interceptions.

*** Tulane's TD was its first since the 4:06 mark of the second quarter of last year's season finale against LSU -- over 144 minutes of playing time.

FLORIDA STATE HEAD COACH BOBBY BOWDEN

"I was very happy to get this win. We did not have a number one team performance. Give Tulane and their coaches a lot of credit. Their offense was something else tonight. They just would not let us get the ball. When we did get the ball, they gave us nothing long. We got only the short stuff. They chose slow death. They just had an excellent plan. This is probably the way I would have played us. Casey overthrew some tonight, but that's going to happen. He did keep finding those tight ends though; didn't he? Our defense is playing well, but mistakes are killing them. A missed assignment here, a penalty there... Mistakes are prolonging drives and changing momentum.

"What scares me is when we play Michigan and they run some of that one back set stuff. Oh my!"
