NOTES & QUOTES

*** The 95-yard kickoff return by Qadry Ismail was the first KO return for a TD against FSU since 1984, when South Carolina's Raynard Brown returned a kickoff 99-yards for a score in Columbia. USC won the game 38-26.

*** Casey Weldon's 22-6f-35 day for 347 yards marked a career high for the FSU senior. Weldon's previous highs were 20 completions (regular season) vs. Auburn last year or 22 completions in the Blockbuster Bowl. He passed for 325 yards vs. Florida last year in the only other 300-yard game of his career.

*** Kevin Knox's five catches for 69 yards in the first half eclipsed his previous CAREER numbers of three grabs for 61 yards.

*** Amp Lee's 106-yard day was his third 100-yard day this year and sixth 100-yard game of his career.

*** Clifton Abraham's interception was the first ever for the freshman from Dallas.

*** QUOTES From FSU Head Coach Bobby Bowden:"

"It was real late in this game before I could ever get comfortable. I told my boys we could not give up big plays and we did that right off the bat. Casey just did great. Casey does one of the best jobs of making the right decision. Two things were definitely in our favor today. The crowd was just fantastic and the heat wore them down. With 5 minutes left in the half they could not pass rush because of the heat. That coach has done a great job with that team. I think if we hadn't seen the Florida game, we might have gotten beat today. I'm so glad we played here and not up there in that dome. This was the first time in my career, I had my kids practice a full week without full pads. I thought the worst thing for us would be to go out with a beat up team. Dadgummit, that Ismail is so good. After playing Howard last week, we thought we were through with those kind. This guy might be better. I'm so happy with how we played overall. With Lee and Bennett in the game, we can do so many things. Really, the heat just took it out of them. You can coach a lot of things, humidity is not one of them."

*** QUOTES from Syracuse Head Coach Paul Pasqualoni:

"We got our butts kicked in every area. We had had things pretty much our own way up until today and it had been fun. Today wasn't fun.

"Coach Bowden and his staff do a great job. We tried to put pressure on Weldon, but they picked it up every time. Florida State is very well prepared for whatever you want to do.

"We didn't come down here to stay close. We came down to win. We didn't do it. You have to be a step ahead of them, not a step behind. We wanted to stop the big plays on first down and put them in third down situations. In the second half, they got us on the first and the third down situations.

"We had wanted to hold the ball offensively so to keep their offense on the side lines. We didn't do it.

"We may have gotten worn down a bit in the fourth quarter.

*** FSU's 642 yards of total offense today was the most ever against a Syracuse team. The previous record for yards against the Syracuse defense was 587, which ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ ~~XXX~~ the Seminoles tallied in the 1978 game between the two teams.

*** The last time FSU had 600 yards of total offense was in 1988, when the Seminoles totalled 638 against South Carolina.

*** Terrell BUCKLEY's fourth interception of the season gives him 13 for his career to rank him along in fourth place on the FSU career INT chart.
