FLORIDA STATE NOTES & QUOTES

*** Terrell Buckley's fifth and sixth interceptions of the season give him a total of 15 for his career. That ties the FSU career record of 15, held by Monk Bonasorte (1977-80).

*** Buckley's 71-yard INT return for a score also tied him with Deion Sanders for the FSU career record for Tds on interception returns with four. He has six total career touchdowns (4 on INT returns, 2 on punt returns). Two of those touchdowns have come against Virginia Tech as he scored on a 53-yard INT return against the Hokies in last year's game.

*** Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

"We were fortunate to have won this game. They play us tough like this every time. They are a fiesty team. I am glad we played this game in Orlando, Florida. I'm just not sure how it would have come out if we had played in Blacksburg.

"Our quarterback was way off today. He just had a rough day, there's no doubt about it. If you had to give credit to somebody, I would say the offensive and defensive lines. Our passing game was just not good. We are going to be a very average team when our passing game is not sharp.

"Virginia Tech is the type of team that gives us problems. They are tough, hard-nosed and their kids just won't give up. I was very disappointed in the way they completed those big passes. Their passing game was excellent and ours was so far off. I haven't seen ours that way in a long time.

"I told our kids they did the No. 1 thing today. And that was win the game. You're just not gonna play great every Saturday. Again, just give Tech credit. They executed better than we did today.

*** Kevin Knox' touchdown catch was the first of his career. Knox is the third FSU player to total over 100-yards in receiving yardage this year. The others: Lonnie Johnson — 154 yards vs. Tulane, Shannon Baker — 139 yards vs. Syracuse.

*** Amp Lee totalled 107 yards on 16 carries -- his fourth 100-yard rushing day of the year and seventh in his career. Lee is the first FSU back to gain more than 100 yards in four different games in a season since Sammie Smith tallied seven 100-yard games in 1987.

*** Dan Mowrey's two missed extra points today give him eight misses on the season. He is 24-of-32 in the PAT department. Mowrey's misses came against BYU (1), Western Michigan (1), Michigan (3), Syracuse (1) and Virginia Tech (2).

*** Florida State's 343 yards of total offense is the lowest total for the Seminoles this season. The previous low was 459 vs. Western Michigan. It was also a low mark in points.
