*** FSU notched its 3rd shutout of 1993 today, making this team the first since 1964 to post three shutouts. That 1964 squad, which was honored here today, actually had four shutouts -- vs. Miami, Texas Christian, New Mexico State and Southern Miss.

*** Through five games in 1993, Charlie Ward has been intercepted just once. Through five games last year, Ward threw 11 INTs

*** Quotes from FSU Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

"It was a great win for us today, but it doesn't mean a thing if we don't win next week. Next week we find out. I was pleased we were able to win so convincingly. I am so proud of that shutout. It was a struggle for a half, but they had a great plan. They wanted to just keep the ball and eat up the clock. If they could have scored early, it might have given them some momentum. They were so well-prepared that it led to some of our problems in the first half. That Davis is a fine quarterback. I think he's very dangerous, but really Georgia Tech wore down. We had too many people. Warrick Dunn must have had a great game. I can't see all that well from my seat on the sideline, but I know he kept handing the ball to the officials. That means he was scoring a lot of touchdowns. Next week people will really be able to prognosticate on what kind of team we've got. If we play our best we can win. If they play their best, they can win. I've got a feeling both of us will play our best and it will be another one of those typical FSU-Miami battles."

*** Quotes from Georgia Tech Head Coach Bill Lewis:

"Congratulations to Florida State. They're as good a football team as I've seen in a long time. You can't compare them to anyone else, though, until the end of the season, but I don't see any weaknesses. You just can't exploit them. On both sides of the ball, they make plays. On offense, their backs run hard and make you miss. Through five football games, they're as good as I've seen in a long time. I don't know where there's a weakness on their team. We looked everywhere we possibly could to see if there was an area we could exploit. They don't have that glaring situation, where you say, we can do this or we can do that. We had some early success, and they seemed to be able to turn it to a higher notch. They've done that continually throughout the season. When they have an opportunity to make plays, they make them. Their backs run hard, they make you miss. They do a great job of throwing and catching. They play hard on defense. I thought early our plan was good and we had some opportunities to get in the end zone, but we couldn't finish drives off. They seemed to always be able to turn it up when they had to. They find ways to handle what you're doing and they have so much speed.

"The only way I can describe Charlie Ward to you is he is absolutely the best. There is nothing else you can say. He can beat you in so many ways. When you pressure him, he makes you miss in the back field. He makes it look almost too easy at times."

*** Quotes from Georgia Tech QB Donnie Davis:

"Florida State's defense was quick and strong as we expected. I thought we moved the ball well in the first half, but it seemed like we let down. I thought we were still in the game heading into the third quarter, but they seemed to raise their play. Charlie Ward is very elusive and makes good decisions. Maybe one day I can do similar things."

*** Georgia Tech was shutout for the first time since October 3, 1987 when N.C. State beat the Yellow Jackets 17-0. Today's shutout broke a streak of 63 straight in which Georgia Tech had scored.
