



PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS & PERSONAL BESTS SET TONIGHT

MIAMI

- MALCOLM PEARSON (UM) his interception of Danny Kanell's pass into the endzone in the first quarter was his third this year and fourth of his career. It led to Miami's first TiD of the game.
- JAMES STEWART (UM) his two TD runs bring his season total to 8. It was also his 4th multiple-TD game and his career TD total is 13.
 - with 95 yards on 16 carries tonight, Stewart topped 1,000 career yards and currently has 1,042. He is the 29th 'Cane to rush for 1,000 career yards. Teammate Larry Jones has 1,241 and is the only other current player with 1,000+ career rushing yards.
- CHRIS T. JONES (UM) 10-yard reception in the first quarter marks his 20th consecutive game with a catch. (UM record is 33 by Michael Irvin and Lamar Thomas)
- C.J. RICHARDSON (UM) grabbed his first interception of the year in the second quarter and returned it 58 yards to set up UM's second TD of the game. He has four during his career.
- DANE PREWITT (UM) connected on two FGMs to nail his 6th and 7th straight field goals. Seven straight is his career best. The UM record is 11 by Carlos Huerta in 1990.
 - his 10 points tonight move him into 6th on UM's career points scored list with 187.
- CARLOS JONES (UM) his interception and ensuing 16-yard return for a TD was the first of his career and second INT this year. It was the first time a 'Cane returned an interception for a TD since Kenny Holmes returned one for 11 yards and a TD vs. Syracuse on 10/23/93 in UM's 49-0 win in the Orange Bowl.
- FRANK COSTA (UM) his 177 yards passing move him into No. 9 on UM's career passing yards with 2,978.

TEAM NOTES

- 5 TIMES AS NICE: Miami's win tonight is the fifth straight against FSU in the Orange Bowl. UM won in 1992, 1990, 1988 & 1986.
- DROPPING IT FOR THE FIRST TIME: James Stewart's fumble in the first quarter was the first time in 124 carries that a UM running back lost the ball. Stewart had carried the ball 87 times without a turnover. Before tonight, the last time a UM back dropped the ball on a rushing attempt was vs. W. Virginia on 11/20/93. It was James Stewart who fumbled the ball in the first quarter against the Mountaineers.
- ONLY ONE TIME IN THE FIRST: FSU's touchdown with 2:20 left in the first half marked the first time this season that a UM opponent has scored in the first half.
- NO. 1 TWO: FSU's two-point conversion in the second quarter was their first of the season.
- MIAMI DRIVES A LONG WAY TO THE ORANGE BOWL: Ryan Collins 1-yard TD pass to Derrick Harris at the end of the first half capped Miami's 89-yard scoring drive, which was the Hurricanes longest this season. The previous season long was an 88-yard scoring drive at Arizona State that went seven plays and ended with Jonathan Harris catching a 53-yard toss from Costa. UM had one other 80+ yard drive when Al Shipman took the ball on the first play and ran 82 yards for a TD against Georgia Southern.
- FROM DEFENDING TO RECEIVING: Miami's 4 interceptions this evening are the most by UM defenders since the final game of the 1993 regular season when UM picked off five passes by Memphis State quarterbacks Tony Scarpino & Clifton Davis. Miami won that game, 41-17, on Nov. 23, 1993.
- PACKING THEM IN: The 77,010 fans who jammed the Orange Bowl tonight is the ninth largest home crowd in UM history. Six of the top 10 attended games have been against Florida (2) and Florida State (4). The largest was 81,634 on Nov. 25, 1989 when Miami defeated
- 31 ADDS UP TO FSU LOSS: The last time FSU gave up 31 points, they lost to Notre Dame, 31-24, last fall. That was FSU's last defeat
- NO PLACE LIKE HOME: With the win this evening, UM leads the FSU series at the Orange Bowl, 13-12.
- ROADBLOCKS: Miami's defense held FSU to just 47 yards rushing. It was the second lowest yardage total this season by a UM opponent. The Hurricanes held Georgia Southern to just 12 yards on the ground in their season opener.
