COACH BOBBY BOWDEN

"We had every advantage today. It was just so hot out there. I can't remember a hotter day out there. We used a lot of players throughout the game and that is an advantage of being the home team.

"Our quarterbacks had a good day throwing the ball. They put it up in the air where our receivers could go and get it. Andre Cooper had a good day. I thought all our receivers played well.

We've got a big strong fullback, two tightends that can catch and block, wide receivers out the ears, two outstanding tailbacks, maybe the best quarterback in the country and a veteran offensive line. The elements are all there. And they may have to carry us."

"We played a great football team. We knew coming in that they were a great, great offensive football team. I've never seen a team that put so much pressure on you in so many different ways and with such great athletes. Even with that, we still had our chances.

"I think they turned three fumbles in our first four tries into two touchdowns. At the end of the game, when it was out of reach, we gave them two more.

"I feel good about this football team. We got beat very badly today by a very good football team and I'm disappointed in that. I saw some signs out there today that showed me we could be a very good football team. We've got to take this and build from it and put it behind us and be ready to go, because we've lost two football games and we have eight more to go. There's nobody on this schedule from here on out that we can't beat. If we get our heads together and play like we did at times today, we'll win those eight football games."
