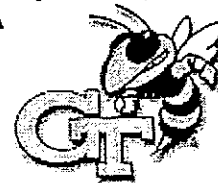

NOTING GEORGIA TECH

- The 140 penalty yards assessed against Georgia Tech are the most in school history. The previous high was 137 in last year's Florida State game
- When Tech went ahead 15-12 in the third quarter, it marked the first time that the Yellow Jackets have led the Seminoles in the second half since 1992, when Tech led 24-14 with four minutes to play before falling 29-24.
- With 443 yards passing, Chris Weinke recorded the second-best total by a Tech opponent. The record is 501 yards by Wake Forest's Rusty LaRue in 1995

Georgia Tech's 15-12 lead in the third quarter marked the first time the Seminoles have trailed this season. During the 1999 season, an opponent tied or took the lead on the Seminoles 14 times. On the ensuing FSU possessions, Chris Weinke led the Tribe to a score nine times (seven TDs, two FGs). On those 14 possessions, Weinke was 42-of-54 (77.8%) for 461 yards and five touchdowns.

CAREER NIGHT FOR CHRIS

Chris Weinke became FSU's all-time career passing yardage leader with 6,433 yards on a career 443 yards tonight, passing Gary Huff (6,378). He also moved into sole possession of third place in FSU career touchdown passes with 50 and into a tie for sixth with Shawn Jones of Virginia on the ACC list. His passing yards moved him ahead of Leo Hart of Duke (6,116), Boomer Esiason of Maryland (6,184) and FSU's Danny Kanell (6,372) and into 12th place on the ACC Career Passing Yardage list.

TRAILING IN THE FOURTH

The last time FSU trailed in the fourth quarter was in last year's National Championship game. The Tribe trailed Virginia Tech 29-28 until FSU's Ron Dugans scored on a 14-yard pass from Weinke with 12:59 left in the game. Tonight wasn't the first time FSU trailed Georgia Tech in the fourth quarter. Back in the 1992 season, FSU trailed Tech 21-7 in the fourth quarter when Charlie Ward instrumented a comeback, giving the Seminoles a 29-24 victory.

PLAYER QUOTES:

Chris Weinke

On his career passing performance tonight:

"That's (his stats) not the important thing. The important thing is that we got a team victory tonight. It was a hard-fought game and that's what we expected going in. Winning the game like we did was a huge victory for us. We knew it was going to be a dog fight from what we saw on film and that it would take 60 minutes of football to leave here with a win and that's exactly what it took."

"This is not an individual game. I'm surrounded by a great group of receivers and it makes it easier when you put the ball in those guys hands. They're (the receivers) are as deserving of this recognition as I am."

On setting the FSU passing record:

"I didn't even know it. I was so focused on the game and getting us a win. It's a great honor when you look at some of the great quarterbacks who have played at Florida State."

"We made a lot of mistakes tonight and we'll have to have more consistency down the road. It's still early in the season so we'll have time to iron those things out."

Jamal Reynolds

"We had an overall good performance on defense tonight. We got the victory and that's all that counts. It's tough to come up here and win. It's always been that way. Everybody kept their head up when they (Tech) took the lead. It's good to have a few close games under your belt. Hopefully, we have those early, instead of later."

Bobby Bowden

"First of all, give Tech a great deal of credit. I thought they played extremely well. I thought penalties really hurt us tonight, but take nothing away from Ga. Tech. Tech fought hard. They didn't quit and we knew they wouldn't. I thought our pass protection was great, but I am still disappointed that we could not get our running game going again. George (O'Leary) had done a great job. He is recruiting more athletes with more speed. He's got quite a few players we wanted. Sometimes we don't find that. Our defense played super. We blew a coverage late on that TD, but Tech does a great job of taking advantage of those mistakes. I thought it was a great game."

"Weinke, I thought played extremely well. He did a good job of adjusting to what they were doing and obviously hit some big plays. He once again showed what he's made of when he brought us back from behind. What Tech was doing puts a lot of pressure in terms of decisions on your QB and I thought he did very well at that."
