The Seminoles played all but 21 of the available players who dressed for the game (a total of 57) in the first quarter alone.

Headed the Other Way

Stanford Samuels' 82-yard interception return for a touchdown was only the second score for the Seminole defense this season. Alonzo Jackson returned an interception 48 yards for a TD against Iowa State in the season opener. Florida State's defense scored six touchdowns in 2001.

Long Stretch for the DB's

Stanford Samuels' interception return for a TD was the first by a Seminole **defensive back** on an interception since Abdual Howard returned one at Virginia last year – a span of 15 games.

Going Deep

Adrian McPherson's 72-yard touchdown pass to Craphonso Thorpe is Florida State's longest scoring play from scrimmage this season. The reception is also the longest of Thorpe's career. The last time Florida State completed a pass of 70 yards or more was in the 2001 Gator Bowl against Virginia Tech when Chris Rix connected with Javon Walker for a 77-yard touchdown.

Scoring In The Second

The Seminoles have had great success in the second quarter this season. Florida State outscored Georgia Tech 14-6 in the second quarter of today's game and have now outscored their opponents 159-50 in the second quarter this season. Last week at Wake Forest was the first time FSU had trailed an opponent at halftime all year.

Give Me The Ball

Junior linebacker Michael Boulware recorded his second interception of the season in the third quarter, which ties him for second on the team with Rufus Brown and Bryant McFadden. Boulware got his first of the season year at Miami on October 12th. In 2001, Boulware finished the season tied for the team lead with three interceptions.

Fourth Quarter Is Auto-Maddox

Senior tailback Nick Maddox has been impressive in the fourth quarter of the last two games. Maddox has carried the ball for a combined 113 yards on 14 carries in the fourth quarter of the last two games. Against Wake Forest, Maddox carried the ball six times for 54 yards in the final quarter.

Another 100 For Nick Maddox

Nick Maddox, who had his first-career 100-yard rushing game last week at Wake Forest, followed up his performance today with 122 yards on 22 carries. Against Wake Forest, Maddox carried the ball 19 times for 122 yards. Today he had 22 carries for 122 yards.

Samuels Seals The Deal

Stanford Samuels' interception in the endzone with 0:17 seconds left in the game sealed the Seminoles 21-13 victory over Georgia Tech. Samuels had two interceptions on the day and put him in the team lead with three picks on the season. Cornerback Bryant McFadden recorded two interceptions in a game earlier this season at Maryland.

Seminoles Second-Half Shutdown

The Florida State defense has not allowed a point in the second-half the last two games (Wake Forest & Georgia Tech). The last time an opponent scored in the second half on the Seminole defense was when Notre Dame scored at the 11:05 mark of the fourth quarter on October 26th, a streak of 71:05 minutes.

NOTING GEORGIA TECH

- Today's game is a sellout (43,719), Georgia Tech's fourth in five home games this season.
- With seven points today, placekicker Luke Manget raised his career total to 313 points and moved into third place in ACC history, passing Leon Johnson of North Carolina (306), Jess Atkinson of Maryland (308) and Ted Brown of NC State (312). He now trails only a pair of Florida State kickers on the ACC's career scoring list: Scott Bentley (326) and Sebastian Janikowski (324).
- Manget extended his streak of consecutive PAT to 154. The NCAA record is 161.
- With 80 punt return yards today, Kelley Rhino moved into second place in ACC history. Rhino now has 1,098 career yards, passing Troy Slade of Duke (1,021). The ACC record is 1,191 yards by Ledel George of NC State.
- With eight punt returns today, Kelley Rhino became Georgia Tech's career leader. He now has 104 career punt returns, breaking the previous Tech record of 101 by Willie Clay (1988-91). Rhino also moved into second place in ACC in history in career returns. The ACC record is 125 by Ledel George of NC State.
- With five receptions for 52 yards today, Will Glover moved into a tie for fourth on Tech's career receptions list with 115. He shares that position with both Bobby Rodriguez (1989-92) and Jerry Mays (1985-89).
- The Georgia Tech offense went two for three on possessions in the red zone today with a touchdown and a field goal, upping its ACC-leading total to 29-for-32 (90.6 percent) on the season. The Yellow Jackets now have 21 touchdowns and eight field goals in those 32 red-zone possessions.
