FIRST HALF NOTES

SCORELESS

While the Seminoles have held their opponents without an offensive touchdown in 10 straight quarters, tonight's game marked the first time this season that FSU was held scoreless in the first quarter and in the first half. In the 2001 and 2002 meetings with the Yellow Jackets, FSU was also held scoreless in the first quarter. Tech scored first in both those games.

RETURN MAN

Sophomore Craphonso Thorpe's 43 yard return in the second quarter was Florida State's longest kickoff return of the season. FSU's longest punt return of the season is by Chris Davis who had a punt return for 38 yards in the fourth quarter of the season-opener at UNC. True freshman Antonio Cromartie is averaging 33.5 yards on two returns tonight and 27 yards per return for the season (three attempts). His career long is 37 yards on tonight's opening play.

THE LAST TIME

The last time FSU was shutout in the first half of a game was in the national championship game vs. Oklahoma on January 3, 2001. In that game, FSU went scoreless through three quarters and managed a safety in the fourth quarter and fell 13-2. The last time FSU was shutout in the first half of a home game was September 20, 1986. FSU trailed UNC 7-0 at the half and the game resulted in a 10-10 tie.

WE TRAILED 'EM HERE BEFORE

The last time FSU trailed at half time in a home game was vs. Georgia Tech on Dec. 1, 2001. The Tribe was down 10-7 at the break and came back to win 28-17. Last year, FSU trailed just three times at half time and went 1-2 in those games. At Wake Forest, FSU trailed 21-17 and won 34-21. At NC State, FSU trailed 10-7 and lost 17-7. In the Sugar Bowl vs. Georgia, FSU trailed 17-7 and lost 26-13.

SECOND HALF NOTES

ALL-TIME PASSING

QB Chris Rix moved into 6th place on FSU's all-time passing yards list. He surpassed Bill Cappleman (1967-69) who had a career 4,904 yards. With tonight's 160, Rix has 5,038 career passing yards, making him just the sixth quarterback in FSU history to pass for 5,000 or more career yards.

SACK ATTACK

After having five sacks on the season, the Seminole defense surpassed that total in tonight's game alone with six sacks. Six different Seminoles recorded sacks in tonight's game. Eleven different guys have recorded sacks for FSU this season.

DO YOU REMEMBER?

In 1992, FSU trailed Georgia Tech 18-7 after three quarters and Charlie Ward orchestrated an impressive comeback, leading the Tribe to 22 fourth quarter points. FSU won the game, 29-24. In 2001, FSU trailed 15-12 after three quarters, but Chris Weinke guided FSU to 14 fourth quarter points.

BOWDEN'S FIRST IN ACC VICTORIES

With tonight's win, Bobby Bowden moved into first place for all-time ACC victories with 86. He surpassed former Virginia coach George Welsh, who had 85 wins in 19 seasons. This is FSU's and Bowden's 12th season in the ACC. Overall, the Tribe is 86-5 in ACC play.

First Half Notes – Georgia Tech at #10 Florida State

- * Georgia Tech has held its opponents without a touchdown on their first drive of the game in 33 consecutive games (since Oct. 28, 2000, vs. Clemson).
- * The Yellow Jackets have successfully converted a fake punt for a first down in two straight games. Tech punter Hal Higgins, who completed the pass in the Jackets' successful first half fake punt, was a quarterback in high school
- * Senior placekicker Dan Burnett converted on two field goal attempts in the first half and is now a perfect 5-for-5 on the season. Burnett, who was a backup to Luke Manget the last three seasons, was 0-for-4 on field goal attempts from 2000 through 2002.
- * In the first half of tonight's game, Tech has run 42 plays to FSU's 15 plays. Entering tonight's game, Tech had only run 107 plays to its opponents 150.
- * Senior wide receiver Jonathan Smith had 4 catches for 64 yards in the first half. Smith moved up to 12th place on the Georgia Tech career receiving yards list with 1285 yards.
- * Tech's defense has held its opponents without a touchdown for 6 straight quarters. The unit has allowed just 55 yards on the ground in the last 6 quarters.
- * The Yellow Jackets have held a half time lead over the Seminoles in each of their last two trips to Tallahassee. Tech also led 10-7 at the half in 2001, but Florida State came back for a 28-17 win.

Game Notes – Georgia Tech at #10 Florida State

- * Georgia Tech has held its opponents without a touchdown on their first drive of the game in 33 consecutive games (since Oct. 28, 2000, vs. Clemson).
- * The Yellow Jackets have successfully converted a fake punt for a first down in two straight games. Tech punter Hal Higgins, who completed the pass in the Jackets' successful first half fake punt, was a quarterback in high school.
- * Senior placekicker Dan Burnett converted on two field goal attempts in the game and is now a perfect 5-for-5 on the season. Burnett, who was a backup to Luke Manget the last three seasons, was 0-for-4 on field goal attempts from 2000 through 2002.
- * In the first half of tonight's game, Tech ran 42 plays to FSU's 15 plays. Entering tonight's game, Tech had only run 107 plays to its opponents 150.
- * Senior wide receiver Jonathan Smith had 4 catches for 64 yards in the game. Smith moved up to 12th place on the Georgia Tech career receiving yards list with 1285 yards.
- * Tech's defense held its opponents without a touchdown for 7 straight quarters until Florida State's Chris Rix scored midway through the 4th quarter. That is the first rushing touchdown Tech has allowed this season.
- * The Yellow Jackets have held a half time lead over the Seminoles in each of their last two trips to Tallahassee. Tech also led 10-7 at the half in 2001, but Florida State came back for a 28-17 win.
- * Free safety Dawan Landry had two takeaways in the ballgame. He recovered a fumble on FSU's first play from scrimmage in the first half and had an interception inside Tech's 10-yard line to end Florida State's first series in the second half.
- * Cornerback Reuben Houston intercepted his second pass of the season in the end zone to end Florida State's scoring threat in the 4th quarter.
- * Tailback P.J. Daniels' 47-yard touchdown run in the 4th quarter is the longest run of his career and Tech's longest run of the season. Daniels' touchdown run was the first touchdown the Seminoles have allowed this season.
- * Daniels is Tech's first 100-yard rusher in a game since Ajenavi Eziemefe's 136 yards against North Carolina on Sept. 28, 2002. Daniels ended the game with a career-high 113 rushing yards.

FSU Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

On the game:

"This was one of those nights where no one was sharp. They did a better job of executing. It was a game where they won the battles, but we won the war."

"I really have mixed emotions about this one. It doesn't seem like we won. It was 54 minutes of getting beat and six minutes of winning. You go back and look at Ohio State last year. They were in those situations and won. That shows a lot of character and I think we should have a lot of character tonight."

"I think their (FSU players) hearts were bigger than our execution. Our execution wasn't what we want it to be. Last year's team would have laid down and not come back. This year the kids would simply not give up."

"I told my team this. After North Carolina, everything went good, but one of these days we're going to have to come from behind. Against Maryland we were able to come back, but then I said one of these days that we were going to be behind by 14 in the fourth quarter and have to come back and that's what we did tonight. I think I've thought of my last scenario."

On not kicking field goal at end of game:

"We felt that field position was more important than points. We didn't want to kick it off and then have them bring it back and give them good field position."

2nd half changes:

"The defense made some changes that really worked for us. Offensively we had to go to the passing game. With their size, they're not real big, but they're quick, we thought we could run the ball. We ended up throwing it the entire first half."

On Georgia Tech:

"They are a much better team. They showed it against Auburn and proved it against us. You have to give so much credit to Georgia Tech. Chan deserves all the credit. They were anticipating much better than we were. It was like a chess match and they always seemed to be a move or two ahead of us."

On Reggie Ball:

"He's a super prospect. He's got a lot of poise for a freshman. His arm is really alive. He'll be a great quarterback for Georgia Tech. They've got a gem there at quarterback. He can run, he's got a great arm and he's sharp."

"It hurts. Anytime you give that kind of effort and you come up short it hurts. I don't care what you say, there are no moral victories but I want you to know that I am proud of that football team and how they fought and the effort they gave. They gave us everything they had tonight. That's all you can ask from a football team. We've got something to build on if we'll come back and bounce back.

"That's exactly what you hope happens is that you learn every time you walk on the field with a young football team. But you look at it and if this is the No. 10 team in the nation then we have a chance to be a good football team if we can build on this. That's the key for us – just to continue to build on this.

"It was a great run by P.J. Daniels. It was 13-0 at that point and I knew we needed to make four or five more first downs somehow in order to ice the thing. I thought they might score one and we were going to make some first downs or score again in order to try to ice the game.

"The defense was on the field a lot more in the second half. And our depth is not what it needs to be but they finally wore us down to a certain extent. And it hurt us.
