"I think it means more to the players than it does to me. The only thing I've ever cared about is winning that next daggum game."

"I use to always throw my hat to the band. I contemplating doing it the last five minutes, but you can't go down there because it would be a penalty for leaving the box. It just so happened that they were down on the field and I walked down there and tossed it to them. They mean so much to me."

SECOND HALF

COLLEGE FOOTBALL'S KING

Today's win over Wake Forest gave FSU head coach Bobby Bowden his 339th career victory, making him the winningest football coach in Division I-A history. Bowden surpassed Penn State's Joe Paterno (338) with the win.

NEW RECORDS

With 159 punt return yards today, sophomore tailback Leon Washington broke a 29-year old Seminole record. The previous record was 137 yards set by Bobby Jackson vs. Virginia Tech on Nov. 16, 1974. The team record for single game punt return yardage was also broken with FSU's 216 yards today. The previous record was 171 yards in that same game vs. Virginia Tech in 1974.

CLINCHED AT LEAST A SHARE

Today's win over Wake Forest assured the Seminoles at least a share of their 11th ACC title. Prior to this season, since joining the ACC in 1992, FSU has won eight league titles outright and shared two others (with Virginia in 1995 and with Georgia Tech in 1998). FSU is the only undefeated team in ACC play this season.

RIX CONTINUES TO CLIMB

- * With 339 passing yards in today's win, QB Chris Rix now has 6,469 career passing yards and moved into second place on the FSU Career Passing Yards list. He entered the game in fourth place all-time and passed Danny Kanell (6,372) and Gary Huff (6,378). Chris Weinke is FSU's all-time leader with 9,839 passing yards.
- * With two passing TDs today, Rix moved into fourth place on FSU's all-time career TD passing list with 50 career touchdowns. He passed Charlie Ward who had 49.
- * With 362 yards of total offense today, Chris Rix now has 7,280 yards of total offense for his career, moving him into 12th place on the ACC Career Total Offense list. That total stands second on FSU's all-time list.

WASTING NO TIME

Florida State had five scoring drives today in 1:17 or less. Four of those drives resulted in touchdowns with the other being a 50-yard Xavier Beitia field goal.

THE SENIOR SCORES

When Fabian Walker hit senior Joey Kaleikini for a 15-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter, it marked the first career touchdown for the former walk-on who plays wide receiver and serves as the team's holder this season. The reception was Kaleikini's second of the season and seventh of his career.

Wake Forest Head Coach Jim Grobe Postgame Quotes:

On FSU scoring a touchdown right before the half:

"Thought it was big coming out of the half. We thought our kids came out ready to play. It was just disappointing when you cut the lead and get a little bit of momentum going and then you give it right back. I don't think it was a momentum thing as much as our defense let them drive down and score right before the half."

On not scoring a touchdown after Chris Rix interception:

"Well had hoped we could get seven there. We had a bad series before that. We had a couple of mistakes offensively down there and that's where you have to be perfect when you get down in the red zone. We hoped to put a touchdown on the board and we really needed to come away with more than three points and that was just our night. We didn't establish the run real well which we felt like we needed to do. I felt like we could throw the football a little tonight but we just didn't have the ability to keep them off balance tonight. We really ended up throwing when we needed to and you can't do that against a team like FSU because they are very talented and can pressure your quarterback and they have really good man coverage guys. They impressed us defensively. They did a nice job."

On the handshake with Coach Bowden while being carried off the field:

"For me it wasn't a bad handshake. I love Coach Bowden. He is not only a great football coach but he is a great man as well. I was happy for him. I hate to lose a football game but I think he is a real class guy and it was good to see him reach that milestone I just wish it wasn't against the Deacs."

On the intensity of FSU wanting to get Coach Bowden the win:

"I didn't notice anything different from them. They generally play with great toughness and intensity. That is a team you are generally going to take their best shot and I think they were ready to play as well as our kids were ready to play. I think in this situation they were just too good for us tonight. They were a better football team. We had hoped to get it into the fourth quarter and make it interesting but they were just too good for us tonight."

On FSU playing better this year:

"They are a better football team. (Chris) Rix is playing better. I think they are healthier and they are able to run the ball better and defensively they are as good as anyone we've played this year."

Before today, the last Seminole to return a punt for a touchdown was Peter Warrick who ran back 59 yards for a score against Virginia Tech in the 1999 National Championship game.

GOING TO THE TIGHT END

Tight end Matt Henshaw's 46-yard reception in today's second quarter was the sophomore's second catch of his career, his career long and also the longest FSU reception of today's first half. Henshaw had a nine-yard reception in the Maryland game earlier this season. The snag was the second longest catch by a tight end this season. Donnie Carter had a 50-yard catch in the Duke game.

THE POINT OF NO RETURN

Florida State recorded 145 punt return yards to Wake Forest's 0 in today's first half. Overall, FSU had 179 vards on returns in today's first half. Wake Forest had 14.

Chris Rix (QB) on throwing out of the bootleg:

"It reminded me a lot of my high school days. I haven't done it that much since I have been here. I feel comfortable in it. We executed it well and hopefully we can do it more and get the same kind of results we got tonight."

Lorenzo Booker (RB):

"I just like to feel like I contributed. It doesn't matter to me how many balls I catch or how many carries I get. If I can make some blocks and take some pressure off somebody else by being a decoy, I just like to feel like I contributed and they gave me the chance today."

Lorenzo Booker (RB) on his fumble:

"I just have to understand that holding on to the ball is my responsibility. I'm not just carrying it for myself. I am carrying it for Coach Bowden, Coach Sexton, the whole defense and the entire team. I have to make that a priority even if I have to work on that more in practice."

Lorenzo Booker (RB) on coach Bowden:

"Coach Bowden is the best coach in college football history. Not only did I get to play for the team I always wanted to play for but I also got to play for the best coach in Division I-A history. I couldn't ask for anything more. This is like a national championship for me."

Leon Washington (RB) his record setting day:

"Somebody mentioned that to me. It is great to be mentioned with all the great returners in Florida State history like Deion (Sanders). It feels great to accomplish that. Their punter out kicks his coverage a lot and we knew that going into the game. Our guys did a great job blocking. I just got the ball and ran straight ahead. Winning the field position battle is the main thing and helping us do that feels great."

WFU Post-Game Notes Wake Forest at Florida State Oct. 25, 2003

The WFU loss...

- ...drops its 2003 record to 4-4, 2-3 in the ACC
- ...moves its all-time record to 370-557-34 and 96-241-5 in ACC games
- ...extends FSU's winning streak in this series to 12 games and gives the 'Noles an 19-2-1 record vs. WFU ...gives WFU a 2-2 record on the road this season
 - Jason Anderson's 38-yard touchdown catch in the first quarter was his fourth of the season, 12th of his career. He now ranks tied for seventh all-time at WFU in career receiving TDs. It was his fifth-longest reception of the season and third-longest TD catch of the year.
 - Anderson also went over the 1,500 career receiving yards mark. Anderson had four catches for 78 yards, lifting his career totals to 81 catches, 1,520 career yards. His career reception average raised slightly to 18.8 a mark which remains in first place all-time at WFU and fifth in the ACC record book.
 - FSU's punt return to start the second quarter was the first punt return for a touchdown by a WFU
 opponent since NC State's Koren Robinson scored on a 61-yarder in Raleigh in 2000.
 - Wake Forest's 13-point halftime deficit was its largest of the season. The previous biggest deficit was eight points (14-6) at Boston College in the season opener. WFU has trailed at the half in five games this season.
 - Cory Randolph's 13-yard run for a touchdown just before halftime was his second touchdown of the season (he also had a one-yard score at Virginia).
 - The Doak Campbell Stadium crowd of 82,393 was the fourth-largest crowd to ever witness a Wake Forest game, behind two games at Michigan (1976 and '88) and a 1985 game at Tennessee.
 - Quintin Williams' third-quarter interception was his first this season, eighth of his career. His 44-yard return was the second-longest by a Deacon defender this season (after Kellen Brantley's 64-yarder for a TD at Duke last week) and is the fifth interception return 35 yards or longer by WFU this season. Williams also recovered a fourth-quarter fumble, accounting for both of WFU's takeaways today. (Riley Swanson forced the FSU fumble).
 - FSU's 48 points marks the first this season a WFU opponent has scored at least 30 points. It is also the most points given up by the Deacs since the Seminoles scored 48 here in 2001.
 - The 24-point final deficit is WFU's worst loss since losing by the exact same score here at Florida State two years ago.
 - In a battle of the ACC's top two teams in turnover margin, the Deacs came out on top with a +1 advantage. FSU had one interception and one lost fumble, while WFU lost one fumble.
 - Eric King recorded four pass breakups on the day, moving up to tie for fifth all-time on WFU's career PBU chart with 26.

"Wake Forest has a very complicated offense. There is a lot of misdirection; you have to focus on your key and everybody doing their job. They gave us some problems but we maintained. We didn't do as well as we thought we would."
