## **CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR**

Its deja vu all over again for the Seminoles against the orange and green of Miami. The last nine games between the two teams have been decided by three or fewer points, Miami has won all nine. Dating back to 1973, Florida State has never beaten a Hurricane team in a game decided by three or fewer points. Florida State started the rivalry with an edge in close games winning three of the first five meetings decided by three or fewer points. The Seminoles are 3-11 all-time in those games. In 18 games decided by seven points or less, Florida State is 5-13. That includes 10 consecutive losses dating back to 1975.

# PUNT, PUNT, PUNT THE BALL

Florida State's seven punts tonight equals a season-high from the Maryland game, September 6. That was FSU's second game of the season. Jesse Stein did well averaging 43.6 yards per punt. The Tribe special teams did an amazing job as well limiting the Hurricane punt returners to just over seven yards per return.

## BACK-TO-BACK BOWL BLUES

With Florida State's back-to-back losses to Miami in the Orange Bowl and Georgia in the Sugar Bowl, FSU has now lost back-to-back bowl games for the first time since 1980 and 1981. Both of those losses came in the Orange Bowl and both came against the Sooners of Oklahoma. In 1980 the Tribe fell 24-7 and in 1981 it was 18-17. It is also FSU's second straight Orange Bowl loss (Oklahoma in 2000 Orange Bowl). Half of Bobby Bowden's bowl losses have now come in the Orange Bowl Classic where he is 3-4.

# **NOTHING IN THE SECOND**

The Miami Hurricanes held Florida State scoreless in the second half marking the first time FSU has been shutout in the second half of a game since November 23, 2002 when NC State downed FSU 17-7. The last time FSU was held without a point in any half was when Clemson upset FSU in South Carolina earlier this season. This is the first time FSU has been shutout in a half twice in a season since 2000 when FSU was held scoreless in the first half at Miami and then again in the first half of the 2000 national championship game against the Sooners in the Orange Bowl Classic.

# NOT COMPLETE

Florida State's six completions in the 2004 Orange Bowl Classic were the fewest by a Seminole team since December 31, 1986 against Indiana in the All-American Bowl. Florida State won that game 27-13 despite completing just six passes for 54 yards. The game prior to that, November 29 versus Florida, FSU completed just five passes in a 17-13 loss. The Tribe was 5 for 16 in that game for 48 yards through the air.

# GETTING IT GOING ON THE GROUND

Florida State's offense was comitted to the ground attack Thursday night and the offense had more success running the ball than they did through the air. The Tribe gained 110 yards on the ground and threw for 96 yards. The last time FSU's offense rushed for more yards than it passed for was earlier this season at Virginia in a 19-14 win. Florida State rushed for 208 yards in that game and tallied 189 through the air.

# **BLOCK PARTY**

When Florida State's B.J. Ward blocked Jon Peattie's fourth quarter field goal attempt, it was the Dallas, TX native's eighth of his career. In the process he set a new Seminole career record for blocked kicks. Half of the juniors eight blocks came this season. The four field goal blocks tied the single season record he set last year. Since 1990, FSU has blocked 41 kicks, 14 of which were field goals.

"Winning the game was a great thrill for our team and our program. FSU is a class act and Coach Bowden is a class coach."

# On the fake punt:

"D.J. Williams is a great player. I just thought if there was a crease, he would make the first down. We only had one yard to go and we weren't really punting the ball well anyway."

"This team has practices as intensely as any bowl team that I have been around."

# On the National Championship:

"I feel with USC winning their game, there should be a split National Championship."

"I think it (tonight's game) was a great matchup for the Orange Bowl. You knew there would be great intensity since we all know each other so well. We were licking our chops over the street talk about a rematch with Ohio State, but when we found out it was Florida State, we knew it would be a very intense game."

## On defense:

"Our defensive coaches did a great job. Coach (Randy) Shannon had them very prepared. We knew we had to play a great defensive game to play a great game."

Since 1973, the Hurricanes are 10-0 against FSU in games decided by four points or less.

#### RUSHING LEADS TO VICTORY VS. FLORIDA STATE

Miami outrushed Florida State 218-110 this evening. Miami's 218 rushing yards marked the most by Miami against Florida State since the 1990 season. Since 1988, the team that rushes for more yards in the Miami and Florida State series has won the game 13 of 16 times. The three exceptions were: last year in Miami when FSU outrushed UM by a 296-115 margin and lost a 28-27 decision, in 2001 in UM's 49-27 win in Tallahassee where FSU outgained UM 214-142 on the ground, but still lost. The first time was in 1992 when FSU narrowly out-gained Miami on the ground 67 to 65, but lost 19-16.

# GAME NOTES 70<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL FEDEX ORANGE BOWL MIAMI HURRICANES 16, FLORIDA STATE SEMINOLES 14 JANUARY 1, 2004 – PRO PLAYER STADIUM

PAYTON NAMED MVP: Miami running back Jarrett Payton was named the 2004 FedEx Orange Bowl Most Valuable Player as he tallied a career-best 131 yards on 22 carries tonight, the top single-game rushing mark against Florida State this season. The previous best by a FSU opponent was 118 by Colorado's Brian Calhoun on September 20. Payton's 131 yards is the 16<sup>th</sup>-best single game FedEx Orange Bowl mark. Payton became the first running back to be named the FedEx Orange Bowl MVP since the award became a single-player honor in 1999. The last running backs to receive the honor were Nebraska's Ahman Green and Tennessee's Jamal Lewis in 1998.

HOMETOWN ADVANTAGE?: The visiting team on the scoreboard has won five of the last six FedEx Orange Bowl games, dating back to the 1999 game between the Florida Gators and the Syracuse Orangemen. The lone "home team" to win was Oklahoma in the 2001 National Championship Game, when the Sooners downed Florida State, 13-2.

SUNSHINE STATE SHOWDOWN A FAN FAVORITE: Tonight's FedEx Orange Bowl game between Miami and Florida State drew a crowd of 76,739, the largest non-Championship OB Game played at Pro Player Stadium and the largest non-Championship FedEx Orange Bowl game overall (played at Orange Bowl Stadium) since the 1989 game (79,480 – Miami 23, Nebraska 3).

MIAMI'S COMEBACK WIN: The Miami Hurricanes improved to 6-3 in nine FedEx Orange Bowl games, the third-most wins in FedEx Orange Bowl history, behind Oklahoma (12) and Nebraska (8). The Hurricanes overcame a 14-13 halftime deficit, becoming the first team to win after trailing at the half since the Michigan Wolverines in 2000. Michigan, who trailed Alabama at the break, topped the Crimson Tide, 35-34.

CLOSE OB SHAVES: Tonight was the fourth time in the last 20 years that the FedEx Orange Bowl was decided by three or fewer points. The last time came in 2000, when Michigan topped Alabama, 35-34.

A ZERO IN THE SECOND HALF: The Seminoles were shut out in the second half tonight, marking the first time a team was shut out in a half in the FedEx Orange Bowl since the 'Noles were blanked in the first half by Oklahoma in 2001. The Hurricanes and Seminoles combined for three points in the second half tonight, the fewest points in a half since Notre Dame and Colorado played a scoreless first half in 1990.

NOT MUCH OFFENSE IN GARNET AND GOLD: The Seminoles collected 206 yards of total offense tonight, the ninth-lowest offensive output in FedEx Orange Bowl history. The last team to post fewer offensive yards in the OBC was Nebraska in 1992, when the Huskers tallied 171 yards vs. Miami.

BACK ON THE FIRST: Tonight's FedEx Orange Bowl game between Miami and Florida State returned to January 1 for the first time in eight years. The 1996 FedEx Orange Bowl (FSU 31, Notre Dame 26) was the last prior game played on New Years Night. The game was played on January 1 for 57 of the first 62 years.

BIG SECOND QUARTER: The Hurricanes and Seminoles posted 24 points in the second quarter tonight, tied for the most points in a second quarter since the 1943 Orange Bowl (Alabama 37, Boston College 21) when the two teams tallied a combined 29 points (ALA 22, BC 7). The 1966 OB featured 24 second-quarter points between Alabama and Nebraska (ALA 17, NEB 7) and the 1997 OB (played on December 31, 1996) between Nebraska and Virginia Teach (NEB 17, VT 7).

#### INDIVIDUAL PLAYER NOTES

#### PEATTIE SETS UM ALL-TIME SINGLE-SEASON FIELD GOAL RECORD

Jon Peattie's three field goals in the first half of the FedEx Orange Bowl Classic were his  $20^{\rm th}$ ,  $21^{\rm st}$  and  $22^{\rm nd}$  of the season. His  $22^{\rm nd}$  field goal set a new Miami school record for field goals in a season. The previous mark of 21 was held by Carlos Huerta (1988) and Todd Sievers (2001). Peattie is now 22 of 28 on field goal attempts this season.

## PEATTIE'S THREE FIELD GOALS TIES UM BOWL RECORD

Jon Peattie's three field goals (32, 44, 51) ties him for the most field goals made in a bowl game in UM history. A Hurricane kicker had accomplished the feat three previous times in school history: Todd Sievers vs. Florida in the 2001 Sugar Bowl; Carlos Huerta vs. Nebraska in the 1992 Orange Bowl; Carlos Huerta vs. Nebraska in the 1989 Orange Bowl.

#### PEATTIE HITS CAREER LONG 51-YARD FIELD GOAL

Jon Peattie hit a career-best 51-yard field goal to give the Hurricanes a 16-14 early in the third quarter.

#### TAYLOR NOTCHES ANOTHER INTERCEPTION

Miami free safety Sean Taylor continues to stalk Florida State's Chris Rix. Taylor picked off his third Rix pass this season in the first quarter. The interception was Taylor's  $10^{\rm th}$  of the season, tying a UM single-season record set by Bennie Blades in 1986. It also ties Nebraska's Josh Bullocks for the national lead this season. It was Taylor's  $14^{\rm th}$  career interception, which ranks fifth in Miami history.

#### WINSLOW SETS UM TIGHT END RECEPTION RECORD

Kellen Winslow's 12-yard catch in the first quarter was the 115th of his career, setting a Miami career record for catches by a tight end. Winslow recorded five catches on the night to give him 119 for his career. The previous record for a tight end was 114 by Willie Smith from 1984-86. He also moved into fifth place on UM's career receptions (regardless of position) charts with the catch.

### PAYTON GOES FOR 100 YARDS

Senior running back Jarrett Payton streaked to the 100-yard barrier midway through the second quarter. On his ninth carry of the night, Payton reached 100 yards with 6:12 remaining in the first half. He broke off runs of 37 and 46 yards during his quick start. It was the third 100-yard rushing game of Payton's career. He finished with 131 yards on 22 carries. His 131 yards tied his career-high.

#### PAYTON GOES OFF AGAINST FSU

Payton's 131 yards rushing marks the most yards rushing against the Florida State defense this season. The previous high was 118 yards by Colorado's Brian Calhoun.

#### MORE ON PAYTON

Payton's 100 yards rushing in the first half marked the first time a running back has rushed for 100 yards in a first half at the Orange Bowl since Virginia Tech's Ken Oxendine in the 1997 Classic. Oxendine had 102 yards in the half.

#### SACK ATTACK

Michael Boulware's sack of Brock Berlin was the first by a Seminole since 1999. In that game Florida State registered three total sacks in the game. After going four consecutive games without registering a sack of a Cane quarterback, the Seminoles seemed to like the feeling. They followed their first sack in four years with another on the very next play of the game.

# PLAYING THE NUMBERS GAME

Maybe it is the warm tropical weather or the culmination of a long season but the Florida State coaching staff is using a full compliment of players tonight. Of the 87 players listed on Florida State's official roster, 55 played in the first quarter of tonight's Orange Bowl. That means 63% of Florida State's squad saw action in the first 15 minutes of the game.

# SPECTACULAR INTERCEPTION

Jerome Carter's interception in the endzone was not only a spectacular individual play but it helped turn the tide in favor of the Seminoles in the first half. The Hurricanes were already up 3-0 and looked to be driving for more. Berlin's pass to the endzone seemed to be headed to Roscoe Parrish but the junior rover tipped the ball to himself, hauled in the interception and returned it out to the 30. Florida State went on to cash in on the turnover and take a 7-3 lead over the Hurricanes. The INT was the second of his career. After recording his first interception versus Clemson, Carter now has two interceptions in his last four starts after recording no interceptions in his first 20 starts.

# ITS BEEN AWHILE

Lorenzo Booker's touchdown at the 14:54 mark of the second quarter put FSU in the lead 7-3. It is the first time Florida State led Miami since the 1:22 mark in the fourth quarter in 2002 at the Orange Bowl when FSU was leading 28-21. It has been 76:28 since the last time FSU was ahead of Miami. FSU never led in the last meeting in Tallahassee on October 11.

# **BOOK'EM LORENZO**

When Lorenzo Booker scored Florida State's first TD of the night, his third of the season, it signaled a good omen for Florida State. Every time Booker has scored a touchdown for FSU this year, the Seminoles have won. He has reached paydirt versus North Carolina and NC State, both Seminole victories.

# SPLIT AND QUARTERED

Florida State's second quarter explosion is a rare sight versus the Hurrican defense. Miami had allowed just 49 points all season in the second quarter, an average of just four points per game. The Seminoles more than tripled that number with 14 points in a span of less than seven minutes. Last time the teams met, it was UM that dominated the second quarter, outscoring Florida State 13-0.

# TIGHT END ZONE

Matt Henshaw's second quarter TD was the second of the season for the converted quarterback and the third of the year by a Seminole tight end. The last time Florida State scored more TD's via the tight end was 1994 when Melvin Pearsall scored five. If you add up all the tight end TD's FSU had from 1997-2002 (4), it is just one more than the number of touchdowns FSU tight ends have scored this year. Henshaw has also scored the most TD's by a tight end in a single season since Pearsall hauled in two as well during the 1997 campaign.
