

FLORIDA STATE HEAD COACH BOBBY BOWDEN

"It seems like years since I stood up here and said we won a bowl game after we won so many in a row. It was special to me not only because I'm the coach at FSU, but because of my years at West Virginia. There was 40 years of my life out there between FSU and West Virginia. It was very sentimental for me.

"West Virginia presented all the problems that I was afraid they would.

"They (WVU) are well coached and they've got a lot of class.

"Friday, we watched a highlight film of the season like we always do and all the big plays came in the first half of the season. I challenged the kids on that. What happened to all the big plays over the second half of the season? We finally popped some out of there today.

"We probably did our best job of blocking today. They probably did too. They had a lot of success on the ground.

"Chris (Rix) played kind of like his career has gone. When he comes out of the huddle he's going to make something happen. You just don't know for which team sometimes.

"I didn't think about taking him (Chris Rix) out of the game in the first half, but it wouldn't have taken much more to make the move.

"I have never been through a year like this. I've never had a year where all of a sudden your offense went dry. We couldn't do anything."

FLORIDA STATE DEFENSIVE QUOTES

Travis Johnson

"I think it was a pretty good effort by our defense. We finished off the game pretty strong.

"Rasheed Marshall is tough to contain. You got to stay in your gaps. I really think the guys stepped up especially in the second half."

A.J. Nicholson

"We really settled down in the second half and pulled out a tough win versus a very good West Virginia team.

"Our defense has been playing well throughout the season. It didn't stop today. Their (West Virginia) offense is powerful and they can really run the ball. It was a challenge. We stood up and prevailed.

(ON HIS INTERCEPTION)

"He (Marshall) threw to the wide receiver and I was in Cover 1. I tipped it but I didn't know where the ball was. I spotted it and made a play. It's like what Leon (Washington) said, ball players make plays. That's what I did."

FLORIDA STATE OFFENSIVE QUOTES

Leon Washington

"When you can run the ball well early, it gives the coaches so much confidence. If it doesn't go well early, it takes some of the confidence from the coaches.

"Here at Florida State, we have high expectations. We got nine wins but our goal is to win 10 and play for a national championship. Things didn't work out this year but hopefully, we'll get better in the off-season and get ready to do it next year.

(on leaving early for NFL)

"If you can't go second round, you might as well come back next year when you'll definitely have a shot at the first round. I would say percentage-wise, 80 percent I'm staying and 20 percent I'm going."

Chris Rix

"The biggest thing I wanted was a win. I had planned on 300 yards and four or five touchdowns but when I walked out onto the field today, I said 'Chris, don't worry about the stats, all you need is a win.'

(on second half)

"You have to credit the coaches. They made some excellent adjustments at halftime with the passing game. We had been executing with the running game all day. Leon (Washington) and Lorenzo (Booker) did a great job and it really all started with the offensive line opening up holes and giving me time to throw."

West Virginia Postgame Notes

Today's Gator Bowl appearance marks WVU's 24th all-time bowl appearance and third under Coach Rich Rodriguez. WVU was 3-1 in bowls during Rodriguez' career as a Mountaineer defensive back.

West Virginia season captains were Rasheed Marshall, Jerry White, Adam Lehnortt and Ben Lynch.

Florida State became just the third team this season to score first against West Virginia. Boston College scored first and led 14-0 before winning 36-17. Virginia Tech scored first and led 16-0 before winning 19-13.

There were no first-time starters for West Virginia. Quarterback Rasheed Marshall leads the Mountaineers in career starts by making his 37th today. Scott Gyorko and Adam Lehnortt both made their 25th consecutive start, WVU's team leaders in that category.

Kay-Jay Harris' 36-yard touchdown reception was his longest catch of the season and his third receiving touchdown of the year.

Entering today's game Brad Cooper had made 43 consecutive extra points, tying him with Jay Taylor for the WVU single-season mark. His missed extra point was his first in 81 attempts.

Dee McCann's interception in the first quarter was his second of the season. He added his third of the season late in the fourth quarter for the first two-interception game of his career.

Kay-Jay Harris' one-yard touchdown run was his 10th rushing touchdown of the season and 14th of his career.

When West Virginia led 12-10, it was WVU's first lead in a bowl game since early in the 2002 Continental Tire Bowl when the Mountaineers led Virginia 10-7 in the first quarter.

Andy Good's 44-yard field goal was his second of the season. He made a 31-yard field goal at Pitt. He added a 34-yard field goal in the fourth quarter to make him 3-for-3 this season.

Kay-Jay Harris went over 100 yards rushing for the fourth time this season. His other 100-yard games were 337 yards against East Carolina, 142 against Maryland and 112 against Boston College.

Media Note – Wide Receiver Chris Henry has announced his intentions to leave WVU for the NFL.

West Virginia Head Coach Rich Rodriguez

"Obviously I'm disappointed we lost the game. I told the team I thought they prepared well and had good focus. But, we made some mistakes and when you make mistakes against good teams, they'll cost you the game."

We moved the ball well. We had longer drives on them than some of their regular season opponents. We just didn't finish drives well and that's disappointing.

On Field Goal Kicking

"After missing those two extra points, I wasn't overly confident in field goal kicking, but we had to give Andy (Good) a chance and he came through on those last couple."

On Chris Henry and his decision to leave WVU for the NFL "I wish him luck. He's practiced hard and played hard. I hope he has a good career."

FLORIDA STATE VS. WEST VIRGINIA January 1, 2005 GATOR BOWL

First half:

SWEET HOMECOMING

Junior tailback Leon Washington's 69-yard touchdown on the first drive of the ball game was not only the Jacksonville, Fla., native's career-long but it was also the longest TD run in Gator Bowl and FSU Bowl history. The drive, which took all of 22 seconds, was the earliest the Seminoles have scored in a game this season. The Seminoles have now scored just three touchdowns in the first quarter this season and all three have occurred on their first possession of the game. The other two times were a Leon Washington TD in the UNC game and a Chris Rix rush vs. UAB.

FIRST QUARTER DEFENSE

West Virginia's two first quarter TDs marked the first time this season that an opponent has scored two touchdowns vs. the Seminoles in not only the opening quarter, but any single quarter. Overall, opponents have scored a combined seven first quarter touchdowns and three of them were on a kickoff return, a punt return and an interception return.

CENTURY MARK

It took just three carries to put tailback Leon Washington over 100 yards this afternoon. Thanks to a career-high 69-yard run, which resulted in a touchdown, Washington already had 118 yards rushing after three carries. He finished the half with 135 yards on five carries. Today's game marks Washington's fifth 100-yard rushing game of his career, including his fourth this season. His career high is 164 yards on 21 carries at Syracuse.

MORE THAN 2002 ALREADY

Leon Washington already has more rushing yards in today's first half than the Seminoles had as a team at the conclusion of the 2002 Gator Bowl. In that game, FSU finished the game with just 104 rushing yards.

THE RUNNING GAME

FSU's 172 yards rushing in today's first half is a new season-high. The previous high was 150 yards rushing in the UAB game. It is the fourth time this season that FSU has rushed for 100 or more yards in the first half.

SEVERAL SEE ACTION

Of the 67 Seminoles available for today's game, 52 of them have seen action in today's first half.



FSU Second Half Game Notes

MVP

Most Valuable Player Leon Washington, a Jacksonville, Fla., native, recorded a career-high 195 yards rushing in today's game. That is the most yards by a Seminole since Sammie Smith had 212 yards vs. Tulane in 1988. It ranks as third best in Gator Bowl history. He was just 10 yards shy of the FSU bowl record which is held by Sammie Smith, who had 205 rushing yards vs. Indiana in the 1986 All-American Bowl. The Gator Bowl record for rushing yards was set in 1966 when Floyd Little of Syracuse had 216 yards. Greg Jones was the last FSU back to go over 175 yards when he rushed for 189 yards vs. Miami in 2002.

ALSO OVER 100

Sophomore tailback Lorenzo Booker joined Leon Washington with 100+ yards rushing in today's game. His 101 rushing yards today marks the third time this season, and third of his career, that Booker has recorded a 100-yard rushing game.

THE LAST TIME

The last time two Seminoles had 100+ yards rushing in the same game was when Rock Preston (126) and Warrick Dunn (124) accomplished the feat vs. Duke on Sept. 2, 1995 in the season-opener.

STILL UNBEATEN

With today's win, FSU remains without a loss in six Gator Bowl appearances with a 5-0-1 mark. Coach Bowden also earned his 19th career bowl win. He is 19-8-1 all-time in bowl games and is second only to Joe Paterno (20) in bowl victories.

STRONG FINALE

Xavier Beitia hit three field goals in today's game marking the first time all season the senior has made three or more field goals. With 12 points today, he finishes his career with 375 points – second only to Derek Schmidt (84-87) who had 393 points.

WAY TO GO CRO

Craphonso Thorpe had one of his best games of the season today. The senior scored his second touchdown of the season and had 73 yards receiving – his second best total of the year. He finishes his career with 18 career touchdowns which ranks 10th all-time at FSU. His 2,153 career receiving yards ranks 7th all-time in FSU history.

300+

FSU racked up a season-high 301 yards rushing in today's win. The last time an FSU team recorded 300+ rushing yards was on August 31, 2002 vs. Virginia when the Tribe had 397 yards. Today's game marks the fourth time this season that the Seminoles have rushed for 200+ yards and FSU is 4-0 in those contests. The other games were 251 vs. UAB, 249 vs. UNC and 258 vs. Syracuse.

A SOD GAME

Today's contest was considered a sod game for the Seminoles. It is the first sod game victory since last year's 38-34 win at Florida. The origin of the sod game dates back to 1962. That year, the team captains of the FSU football team returned to Tallahassee with a piece of sod from Sanford Stadium as a trophy from the team's 18-0 victory over the University of Georgia. The turf was presented to Dean Coyle E. Moore, who founded the continuing tradition of the sod game. Sod games represent road games that the Tribe wins when they are significant underdogs, however, all bowl games are now considered sod games as well no matter who is favored.
