

MIAMI (AP) — University of Florida won both the varsity and freshmen events in a collegiate cross country meet today, with new records set in each.

Florida was first in the varsity event, at five miles, with 35 points. Miami had 40, Florida State, defending champions, 50, and University of South Florida 84.

Frank Lagotic of Florida was first in 26:25, a meet re-

cord. The old record of 26:33 was set in a dual meet earlier this year by Fred Blackburn of Miami.

In the freshman event, at three miles, Florida won with 36 points. Miami had 43 and Florida State 46.

The winner of individual honors was Fred McKillip of Miami in 14:50, a record. The old record was 15:12 set by Chris Quimby of Miami in 1964.
