

Seminole Golf Squad Racks Up Second Victory

Florida State University's Seminole golf squad racked up its second victory of the season over the University of Georgia Savannah branch linksmen at the local Country club course Saturday afternoon with a decisive 15-3 triumph over the Bulldogs.

The Seminoles had gained an early-season victory over the Georgia golfers in Savannah to account for their other triumph.

Coach Ed Burleson's charges turned in their steadiest performances of the season in chalking up their victory.

Tied for Medal

Hank Mercer, FSU, and Bill Faulkner, UGS, who were paired against each other in the individual matches, tied for low medal as they both turned in 74's.

Sonny Tinney, Florida intercollegiate golf titleholder, took runner-up honors with a 75.

Match scores:

Tinney (FSU), fired a 75 to defeat Jimmy Stevenson (UGS), 2 1-2—1-2. Stevenson had a 76.

Faulkner (UGS), defeated Mercer (FSU), 2-1. Both had 74's.

Capt Ed Andrews (FSU) shot a 76 to defeat Tommy Sharpley (UGS), 3-0. Sharpley had an 83.

Bill Rice (FSU), defeated Bernie Inhulson (UGS), 2 1-2—1-2. Rice had a 78 to Inhulson's 81.

Tinney and Mercer won over Stevenson-Faulkner 3-0, and Andrews and Rice defeated Sharpley-Inhulson 3-0.
