

FSU GOLFERS TOP JAX NAVY

**Score Third Win
In Row 20-7**

JACKSONVILLE, Apr 9. —Florida State University's strong six-man golf squad scored a 20-7 decision over the Jacksonville Naval air station team here today with a display of well-balanced strength.

The victory was the Seminoles third successive triumph without a defeat this season. They had previously beaten Georgia and Mercer.

Ted Hewitt and Hank Mercer paced the Indians to their triumph with a pair of one over-par 73's that took medal honors in the dual meet.

Hewitt was rocking along one-under regulation figures until the 14th hole when he broke his driver. He used his brassie over the remaining holes, but slipped one-over par in the process.

Sonny Tinney and Wiley Watkins both fired 75's to take runner-up honors to the medalists.

Dick Montney had a 78 and Joe Bassett a 79 to complete the Semipole scoring.

Scott was low man for the Naval team with a 76.
