

FSU Golfers Hand Rollins Decisive Loss

Florida State University's Seminole golf team closed out its home season yesterday, taking a decisive 15½-2½ victory over the Rollins Tars at the Country club course.

The Seminoles, who play their remaining dual matches and tourneys on the road, were paced to their triumph yesterday by Bud Marsee's fine two-under-par 70.

Marsee was the only player able to beat par over the hilly, wooded local layout.

Dick Montney was runnerup to Marsee with a 73.

Yesterday's triumph was the sixth of the season for Coach Bob Harbison's team against two losses and a tie. The tie was with Rollins in an early season match at Winter Park.
