

Dick Parker, a junior playing his first competitive college

match, stroked a three-under-par 69 to pace Florida State to a 27-0 decision over Jacksonville Navy here yesterday.

Playing the No. 6 position for the Seminoles, Parker fashioned his subpar round at Tallahassee Country Club in some of the season's best golf weather. Teammate Don Torppa cracked par with a 71, and State's Mel Fleischer matched it with a 72.

It was the third dual triumph in four starts for Coach Bill Odeneal's Seminoles, who host Rollins in their next outing here Saturday.
