

All-America Bob Shave bested par for the third time in four days to spark Florida State to a 21-6 golf victory over Georgia Tech here yesterday.

Shave, St. Petersburg senior, shot a one-under-par 71 at Capital City Country Club for medalist honors. He had a 65 against Rollins Friday and a 67 against Georgia Saturday, giving him 13 strokes under par for his last three efforts.

Sophomores Frank Malara and Downing Gray shot 73s as Bill Odeneal's Seminoles claimed their third 1959 triumph over a Southeastern Conference enemy. FSU has lost one match and tied one.

The Tribe will compete in the Miami Invitational meet at Coral Gables Thursday through Saturday.
