

Florida State's unbeaten golf team swept by Georgia Tech and Springfield (Mass.) in a three-way match, 17-1 and 18-0, at the FSU course Monday.

Richie Karl, sophomore from Endicott, N. Y., playing in the Seminoles' third position, carded 71's in both rounds. Dennis Lyons, diminutive St. Petersburg sophomore, was close behind with two rounds of 73.

FSU won its fourth and fifth victories of the year. The Seminoles golfers face South Carolina and Springfield today in another three-way match. Thursday, Friday and Saturday they're in Miami for the Miami Invitational Tournament.

Florida State's freshman team defeated the Georgia Tech frosh 8½-3½, then downed Springfield's junior varsity, 12-0.
