

Tigers Are Second In Buckhaults Play

MOBILE, Ala., March 17. Memphis State University's golfers rallied to be second in the Buckhaults Intercollegiate Invitational golf tournament Friday, but the Tigers still were 30 strokes behind winner Florida State.

The Tigers began Friday's round in fourth place, but finished ahead of Southern Mississippi and Mississippi, which were second and third after the first round.

Florida State scored 835 for the 54 holes, with MSU scoring 856, Southern 866 and Ole Miss 869.

Carl Dicesare of Florida State was the individual champion with 70-65-64—199. Hubert Green, Southern Amateur champion of Florida State, was second with 69-70-65—204; Chuck Rea of Ole Miss was third with 74-71-65—210; and Russell Glover of Memphis State was fourth with 73-72-66—211.

MOBILE (AP) — Florida State, paced by Carl DiCesane and Hubert Green, won the 54-hole Buckhaults Golf Tournament team title Friday by an overwhelming 30 strokes.

DiCesane took the individual title with a 54-hole total of 199, 17 strokes under par. He was six strokes under par for Thursday's 27 holes and lopped 11 more strokes off standard figures today.

Green finished second at 204, 12 strokes under par. Mississippi's Chuck Rea was third at 210.

USM tied for second in golf tourney

MOBILE Ala (AP) — Florida State held a six-stroke lead today as the final round began in the 54-hole Buckhaults Memorial golf tournament.

The Seminoles opened the tourney Thursday with a 27-hole total of 426. Defending champion Mississippi and Southern Mississippi tied for second with totals of 432.

They were followed by Memphis State 434, host Spring Hill 440, Mississippi State 449, Loyola of New Orleans 456, Pensacola Junior College 465 and Delta State 466.

Carl DiCesre of Florida State led in the individual competition with a three-under-par 102. Other leading scorers were Dennis Walters of Spring Hill and Buddy Whitten of USM, 103 each; Hubert Green of FSU 104; Bill Yandell of USM, Greg Powers of MSU and Don Fruge of Ole Miss, 107 each; and Jim Conace of FSU, and Bobby Day and Neal Lovelady, both of Ole Miss., each with 108.

Florida State Golfing Winner

MOBILE, Ala. (AP)—Florida State won the 54-hole Buckhaults golf tournament team title by 30 strokes Friday.

Paced by Carl DiCesare and Hubert Green, FSU finished with 835 strokes.

DiCesare took the individual title with a 54-hole total of 19, 17 strokes under par. Green was second at 204, and Mississippi's Chuck Rea was third at 210.

In team scoring, Memphis State was second with 865. Southern Mississippi was third at 866.
