## *Voyles and Alwin finish in top 20 of NCAA golfing finals Saturday*

Sophomore Ben Voyles and junior Mark Alwin from Florida State finished high in the individual standings in last weekend's NCAA golf championships. The four-day, 72-hole event was held on the Tucson, Ariz., National Golf Club course.

Competing against the finest college golfers in the nation, Voyles finished 16th in the individual standings with a total of 293. His best round came on the first day of the tourney when he sank a 10-foot putt on the 18th green for a flashy 69. He followed the next day with a 71, but tapered off somewhat the next two days with scores of 77 and 76.

"Voyles played real well," commented FSU golf coach Scott Fletcher. "He certainly matured in this tournament, and I expect him to be especially tough in his next two years here at Florida State. It's always a pleasure to watch a golfer mature from a boy to a man, and that's exactly what Ben did during this tournament."

The other FSU golfer to survive the cut after 36 holes was Alwin, whose final total of 296 put him into a tie for 19th place in the individual standings. His rounds were 70, 75, 74 and 77.
