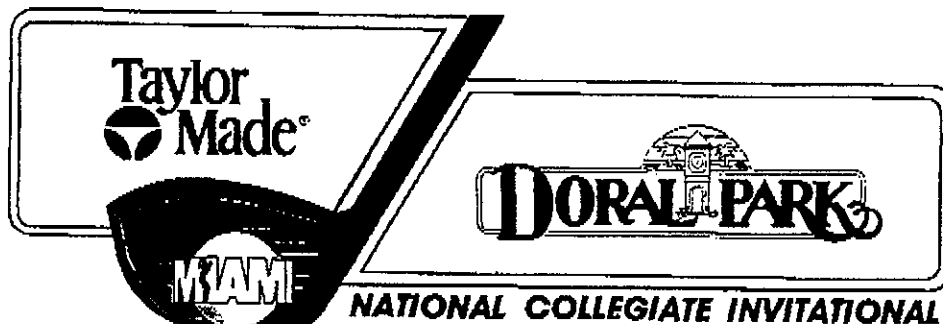

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WAKE FOREST CAPTURES TAYLOR MADE/DORAL PARK TOURNAMENT Team and Individual Records Shattered

MIAMI - Wake Forest's Tony Mollica fired a course record eight-under par 64 to lead the Demon Deacons to the title in the fourth annual Taylor Made/Doral Park National Collegiate Invitational. Wake Forest set tournament records with a 14-under par final round 272 and a 54-hole total of 856, eight under par, for a six-shot victory over second round co-leader Florida.

"This was an unusual, exceptional round," said Wake Forest coach Jesse Haddock, whose team captured the title at Doral Park in 1987. "I'm grateful to the four seniors on our team; they're the ones who did it. We were very fortunate today and are thrilled to win because I know of no other tournament that's better host

Florida's Pat Bates won the individual title with a record-breaking 54-hole total 210, six under par on the par 72 Doral Park Silver Course. His teammate Jeff Barlow and Wake Forest's Tim Straub finished three shots back at 213, while Mollica, Georgia's Matt Peterson and LSU's David Toms were another shot back at 214. Clemson's Chris Patton, who finished the second round just a shot behind Bates, withdrew after spending the night at Doctor's Hospital in Coral Gables, suffering from dehydration.
