STATESBORO, Ga. -- Georgia Southern's Richie Bryant sank a 30-foot birdie putt on the first hole of a sudden death playoff to earn medalist honors at the 19th Annual Chris Schenkel Invitational Sunday. Bryant and Louisiana State's Greg Leshar finished regulation play even at 208. Bryant became the first Georgia Southern player to win individual honors since Jimmy Ellis won the '73 Schenkel.

Louisiana State won the team title, shooting a third-round best 285 for a 12-under-par 852 total. Leshar fired a 67 while David Toms carded a 71 to lead the Tigers.

Clemson, who led after the first two rounds, shot a team total 288 Sunday to finish as runner-up with a 853. Host Georgia Southern had its best finish since 1979 in third place.
