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CENTRAL FLORIDA WINS STATE GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP ...Miami's Medlin wins individual crown

CORAL GABLES, FL-- The University of Central Florida men's golf team combined for a seven-under par 281 over the last 18 holes of the 43rd Annual State of Florida Championships at Miami's Doral Park- Silver Course to win the Division I state championship Tuesday afternoon.

Miami senior Scott Medlin won the overall individual medalist honors by carding a 10-under par, 54-hole total of 206. The title is the Rockingham, North Carolina native's first collegiate victory, he finished second to teammate Dennis Postlewait at the Stanford/US Invitational earlier this year. Postlewait, also a senior, tied Central Florida's Kevin Altenhof for second place with six-under 210 scores.

Entering Tuesday's final day of 27 holes, the Golden Knights trailed host Miami by six strokes and second place Florida State by five, however by the time Dale Wilson's golfers made the first of two turns UCF had pulled ahead of the field on the strength of a 12-under effort. Miami (861) finished second and Florida State (864) third.

"Gutsy golf" is the way UCF Golf Coach Dale Wilson summed up the Knights' performance. "We had a good first round, terrible second nine (holes) and went into the final 18 holes with a challenge. We accepted that challenge and did everything we needed to win. This team showed a lot of character today."

With the win Central Florida won its second State title in three years. The Knights earned the 1987 flag at Daytona Beach and finished tied for second with Florida State behind Florida last year at Palm Coast, FL. The tournament is run by the Florida Golf Coaches Association.

Florida Southern captured the Division II state title and the University of North Florida grabbed the NAIA crown.
