The 1990 NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championships, hosted by the University of Florida at the Innisbrook Island Course in Tarpon Springs, Fla., again promises to be one of amateur golf's greatest spectacles. Thirty teams and an assortment of individuals will play 72 holes, June 6-9, to determine the 93rd NCAA Golf Championship. Below is a look at this year's event, up-close and personal.

How They Got Here

The 30 teams and individuals were selected from Regional Tournaments May 24-26. The regionals were held in three locations: East Regional at Savannah Inn and Country Club in Savannah, Georgia; Central Regional at Ohio State

University Scarlet Course in Columbus, Ohio; West Regional at New Mexico State University Golf Course in Las Cruces, New Mexico.

The Testing Ground—The Innisbrook-Island Course (Par 72, 6,999 yards)

The Innisbrook Island Course is a great test to golf. Generally speaking, it is a very fair course with good length and a lot of water. The heart of the course is holes six through 11, which provides a demanding stretch, with a lot of character. That string also puts a premium on driving the ball in the fairway. Weather—breezy conditions and some mid-afternoon rain showers—could be a factor, as the course is one-half mile from the Gulf of Mexico.

When Checking The Leader Board

A daily team score is computed by totaling the lowest scores of four of the five team members. The final team

score is determined by totaling each daily score. The team and individual champion will be determined after 72 holes (four rounds) of play. In the event of ties, sudden-victory playoffs will be used.

A Chip Shot From The Future

As always, there are a number of future pros playing in this year's NCAA field. The NCAA Golf Championships, along with the U.S. Amateur, is regarded as the best amateur field assembled year-in and year-out. As a point of reference, in 1985, the last time the University of Florida hosted this event, nearly 25 players from that field went on to earn their pro card and play on the PGA Tour.

Teams To Watch

The Favorites: Three teams stand out in **Oklahoma State**, **Arizona State** and **Florida**. **Oklahoma State** is there every year and always competitive. The Cowboys have one of the premier programs in the nation and may be difficult to beat. Watch out for **Arizona State** also. The Sun Devils, led by defending NCAA individual champ Phil Mickelson, are consistently ranked among the country's elite and have a traditionally strong program. **Florida's** Gators have had a strong year and bring a veteran team to the NCAA's this time around. Although Innisbrook is not the Gators home course, **Florida** should feel comfortable with the surroundings.

Pushing The Leader Board: **Texas**, **Georgia Tech** and **Clemson** will be right there come Saturday afternoon. **Texas** has a lot of depth and has continued to improve all year. The Longhorns didn't lose a player from last year's team which finished second. **Georgia Tech** can be explosive and is capable of burning up the course. The Yellow Jackets could be dangerous. Here comes **Clemson** again. The Tigers have perhaps the best one-two combination in U.S. Amateur medalist Chris Patton and Oswald Drawdy.

Chance To Challenge: **Oklahoma**, **Arizona** and **Texas El Paso** will provide stiff competition and might just leave Tarpon Springs with the NCAA crown. The Sooners, the defending NCAA champions, lost just one player from last year and has the experience to handle the pressure. The young, talented Wildcats have good depth and could also be in the hunt. Look out for the Miners of UTEP. The twosome of David Bishop and Paul Stankowski is solid and could provide an upset.
