THIRD/FINAL ROUND RESULTS

SAVANNAH, Ga. -- Michael Christie (70) and Morgan Beam (72) led South Carolina to a one-over-par 289 Sunday, helping the Gamecocks hold a two-day lead and capture the team championship of the Kemira Intercollegiate Invitational Golf Tournament Sunday.

The 54-hole event was played at the par-72, 6,876-yard Sheraton Savannah Resort & Country Club.

South Carolina, who shot a 12-under 276 in Friday's first round and recorded an even-par 288 Saturday, earned its first tourney title of the season. Tulsa earned runner-up honors with a five-under 859 after shooting a 293 third-round total. Ohio State finished third with a two-under 862 while Alabama was fourth after posting a 863.

Tulsa junior Scott Robertson earned individual medalist honors with a 10-under 206. Robertson recorded rounds of 69, 68 and 69. Alabama's Morten Olander, who finished with a 209, placed second, while Christie was third with a 210 total.

Georgia Southern, which finished 11th overall, posted the round's top score Sunday with a five-under 283.

Out of the 180 total rounds played during the tournament, 74 were completed par or better. Thirty players scored 72 or better Friday, while Saturday and Sunday produced 22 rounds of par or under.
