DUSTIN PHILLIPS NAMED AS AT-LARGE PARTICIPANT IN THE NCAA GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Florida State senior Dustin Phillips has been selected as an at-large participant in the 1992 NCAA Golf Championships in an announcement made by the NCAA on Tuesday.

Phillips, a native of Deerfield Beach and graduate of Zion Lutheran High School, will compete in the South Regional along with at-large selections Guy Hill of Miami and Andrew Parks of South Alabama.

Phillips finished among the top 15 in four tournaments during the spring with a top finish of 10th at the Southeastern Intercollegiate in Montgomery, AL. Phillips' low round of the season was a 69 which he shot in his final competitive round at the Kemira Intercollegiate.

Florida State will close out the regular season on May 15-17 at the ACC Championships hosted by Wake Forest.
