TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Florida State Athletic Director, Bob Goin announced Dr. Ernie Lanford as the new head coach for men's golf at Florida State.

Lanford, 56, has been an associate professor at Augusta College and the Director of its NCAA Division I golf program since 1982. His Augusta team won the Big South Conference Championship five times and Lanford is a five-time NCAA Division I Golf Coach of the Year.

He earned his bachelors degree from Florida State in Business, a Master's in Physical Education from Michigan State and a doctorate from Brigham Young.

"We've attracted a nationally known coach of excellence," said Goin.
"His record speaks for itself. He is an educator, an outstanding recruiter and a great team man."

"We definitely got the top candidate," said Associate Athletic Director Jan Stocker. "I feel confident (Lanford) will come in and do a great job for our program."

Lanford was previously involved in the junior golf program, an athletic director at Flagler College and held teaching and coaching positions at State University of New York, Brigham Young and Michigan State.

He is a member of the Professional Golfers Association of America, the National PGA Junior Golf Association, and the American Association of Junior Golfers.

Lanford will assume his post at Florida State the first of the year.
