Tallahassee, FL - Florida State Senior Keith Rick captured his first collegiate victory Monday in Knoxville at Tennessee's Tournament of Champions. Rick's final round of 72, following opening rounds of 72 and 68 was enough to edge out East Tennessee State's Garrett Willis by one stroke.

In the team standings, the Seminoles finished in a tie for fifth after the completion of play at the 6,948 yard Holston Hills course.

The Seminoles posted a final day 295 to compliment opening scores of 298 and 290. The team total of 883 was eleven strokes behind Alabama, who led the event from start to finish.

FSU Senior Bobby Cochran had his second consecutive top ten effort, placing seventh after posting 73-72-71.

Other Seminole finishers include: Christian Raynor, 74-71-74, tied for 15th; Ryan Perna, 79-79-78, tied for 66th; and Jason Doyle, 80-79-83, tied for 72nd.

Florida State travels next to Columbus, GA for the Dixie Intercollegiate October 18-19.
