TALLAHASSEE-The Florida State men's golf team finished second out of seventeen teams in their host tournament, the Seminole Classic, held at the Seminole Golf and Country Club. FSU fired a final round 291 which was five strokes off the pace set by Central Florida. FSU entered the final round with a five stroke lead over UCF.

Individually, Christian Raynor lost on the second hole of sudden death to Robert Damron of Central Florida for individual honors. This marks the second straight tournament Raynor, (74-68-71-213), has been the runner-up. Jason Williams, (72-73-69-214), finished in a tie for third place, but since he was entered as an individual did not factor in team scoring. Ken Stanton, (74-74-73-221) entered as an individual, and Tony Ziegler, (76-68-77-221), both finished in a tie for 12th. Denny Tymosko, (74-70-78-222), finished in a tie for 16th.

Other Seminole golfers included Bobby Cochran, (78-76-69-223) in 22nd, Corey Hamlin, (73-76-75-224), in a tie for 27th, Keith Rick, (74-74-78-226), in a tie for 37th, Ryan Perna, (77-80-74-231), tied for 51st, and Jason Doyle, (80-78-76-234), tied for 58th. Florida State's next tournament is the Southeastern Invitational in Montgomery, Alabama on March 25-27.

TALLAHASSEE-Defending national champion Florida State held their third football workout of the spring on Tuesday afternoon at Ed Williamson Fields adjacent to Doak Campbell Stadium.

"I thought we had a good workout today," said FSU head coach Bobby Bowden, who begins his 19th season at Florida State in 1994. "We got a lot accomplished and I thought all three quarterbacks (Dan Kanell, Jon Stark and Thad Busby) showed positive signs."

Tailback Warrick Dunn and E.G. Green (hamstrings), and guard Chad Bates (foot sprain) did not practice today due to previous injuries. Cornerback Rodney Wells suffered the workout's only injury when he dislocated a finger on his left hand.

The Seminoles practice again tomorrow, then hold their first scrimmage of the spring on Thursday. The annual Garnet and Gold game is set for Saturday, April 9 at 2 p.m. in Capital Stadium.

WINTER SPRINGS, FL-Karen Stupples took individual honors while Florida State's women's golf team won the team title

at the Spalding-Peggy Kirk Bell Invitational at Tusawilla Country Club in Winter Springs. Florida State shot a final round 306 to defeat second place South Carolina by five strokes.

Stupples shot an even par 72 to nudge Florida International's Moira Dunn by one stroke. Maria Casteluuluci gave FSU two golfers in the top ten as her final round 74 was good for a tie for ninth.

Other Lady Seminole golfers include Mabel Pascual del Pobil, (80-81-74-235), in a tie for 12th, Tiffany Faucette, (83-78-81-242), in a tie for 31st, and Kate Burton, (81-83-85-249), in a tie for 53rd.
