FLORIDA STATE WOMEN'S GOLF WINS LADY GATOR

GAINESVILLE, FL - The Florida State women's golf team shot a final round score of 312 and hung on to win the Lady Gator Invitational in Gainesville, Florida.

FSU's three-day total of 919 was two strokes better than the University of Georgia and three strokes better than Florida.

FSU's Karen Stupples won the individual honors by shooting 73-76-76-225. Although she has place in the top ten of every tournament this year, the championship is Stupples' first of the season.

Mabel Pascual del Pobil finished tied for 9th, Tiffany Faucette tied for 12th, and Aguri Okura tied for 17th.
