FSU MEN'S GOLF IN FINISH FIFTH AT ACC'S

NEW LONDON, NC --The Florida State men's golf team shot 294-288-288-870 and finished in fifth place at the Atlantic Coast Conference Championships this past weekend in New London, North Carolina.

North Carolina won the team championship with a total score of 849, thirteen strokes ahead of Georgia Tech. Virginia was third followed by Clemson, Florida State, N.C. State, Wake Forest, Duke, and Maryland.

Hank Kim of N.C. State captured the individual medalist honors with an 8-under par 70-68-70-208. Kim finished three strokes ahead of FSU's Christian Raynor and Clemson's Richard Coughlan. Florida State's Ken Staton finished tied for 13th.
