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### FLORIDA STATE'S MEN'S GOLF TEAM FINISHES TIED FOR FOURTH

October 2, 1995

TALLAHASSEE--The men's golf team finished tied for 4th at the University of Tennessee's Tournament of Champions held at the Holston Hills Country Club in Knoxville, TN. The Seminoles were led by the play of George McNeill who carded an even par 72 in today's final round for a two-day total of 214(12th). Sean Ashby finished tied for 17th with a 218.

East Tennessee State claimed the team championship by posting a 54-hole total of 857, two strokes better than second-place Louisiana State. The Virginia Cavaliers claimed third place while the University of South Carolina finished tied for fourth with the Seminoles.

Garrett Willis of East Tennessee State claimed the individual championship with a three-round total of 205. John Curley of Florida Southern took second place, two strokes behind the winner Willis. Keith Nolan of East Tennessee State claimed third and Jay Hobby of Auburn came in fourth place.

The Seminoles next tournament will be on October 22-24 at the Jerry Pate Intercollegiate hosted by the University of Alabama at the Shoal Creek in Birmingham, AL.
