WOMEN'S GOLF FINISHES THIRD AT RYDER-STATE TOURNAMENT

MIAMI, FLA.--The Florida State women's golf team shot a three-round total of 928 to place third at the Ryder-Florida Women's Collegiate Championships, held at Miami Lakes Country Club. They finished behind the University of Florida and the University of Miami.

The Lady Seminoles had a good showing individually as four team members finished in the final top twenty. Kate Burton tied for 8th place with a three-round score of 229, only nine strokes off the individual champion, Riko Higashio of UF.

The women's golf team has concluded their regular season, and heads to Greensboro, N.C. for the ACC Championships next weekend.

MEN'S GOLF MOVES UP TO FINISH 6TH AT AUGUSTA COLLEGE INVITE

AUGUSTA, GA.--The Florida State men's golf team overcame a second round score of 313 by firing an even-par 288 in the third round at the Cleveland Golf-Augusta College Invitational. The strong final round moved them into a sixth place finish for the tournament, held at the Forest Hills Golf Club. The University of Nevada-Reno won the tourney in a sudden death playoff with the University of South Alabama.

Seminoles Richard Fulford and George McNeill shot a three-under and one-under par in the final round to finish in a tie for 12th place individually. Don Carpenter, who competed as an individual for this tournament, also shot a one-under par in the final round to finish tied for 25th.

The men's team has also concluded their regular season and will compete in the ACC Championships in New London, N.C. on April 19-21.
