MCNEILL FINISHES SECOND, FSU TEAM FINISHES FOURTH AT ACC'S

New London, NC--George McNeill finished second in the 42nd Annual ACC Championships at the Old North State Club at Uwharrie Point. McNeill fired a final round of 72 to remain in second place. Richard Fulford slipped to a tie for third after a round of four-over par 76.

The Seminoles finished fourth in the tournament, 13 strokes behind winner North Carolina. The Tribe entered the day in second place.

The University of North Carolina claimed the team championship, beating Virginia by nine strokes. Clemson fired a team total of 281 today to finish in third.

Mark Wilson of North Carolina won the individual title, beating McNeill by two strokes. Five golfers finished tied for third.

TAR HEELS TAKE SECOND STRAIGHT TITLE *UNC's Wilson wins individual championship*

(New London, N.C.) - For the second straight year, the North Carolina men's golf team won the Atlantic Coast Conference title, taking the 1996 championship by nine strokes over runner-up Virginia. Tar Heel junior Mark Wilson won the individual crown with a three-day total of 73-68-69-210.

As a team, North Carolina shot 290-284-289-860; Virginia placed second at 292-290-287-869 and Clemson third at 297-292-281-870.

Wilson opened the event with a 73 on Friday, but was the only player to shoot two rounds under 70, totalling 73-68-69-210 for the tournament. Sophomore George McNeill of Florida State shot 71-69-72-212 to place second, two strokes behind Wilson. Five players tied for third, all shooting 214, including Seminole junior Richard Fulford, who set a course record of 66 in the first round and was the tournament's leader after the first and second rounds. Fulford finished the ACC Championships at 66-72-76-214.

In the race for the team title, the Tar Heels led Florida State by four strokes heading into Sunday's final round at the par-72, 7,102-yard Old North State Club. North Carolina held its lead for the final round with a team score of 286. The Seminoles faded with a team total of 295 and were passed by Virginia and Clemson. The Cavaliers shot 287 as a team on Sunday, while Clemson's Tigers shot the 1996 tournament's best team round, a 281 to jump from sixth to third.

The ACC championship for North Carolina was the program's second in a row and 10th overall. The Tar Heels shot a 293-283-273-849 last year, on the same Old North State Club course, to take the 1995 title.
