# **SEASON IN REVIEW**

The 1996-97 season had some exciting moment for the Florida State men's golf team. They placed first in a major tournament and had many high individual finishes during the season. However, the loss of All-ACC player junior Richard Fulford, who turned pro, left the team in a state of transition and rebuilding with many young players. As a result, Coach Ernie Lanford's squad was unable to continue their four year streak of play in the NCAA championships.

The season began in September at the Keswick Club Cavalier Classic in Charlottesville, Virginia. The Tribe finished in tenth of 14 teams participating. Leading the way was Jason Pool who finished in fifth place after firing a 214 over three rounds.

The men finished the Fall half of their season by participating in the University of Tennessee Tournament of Champions where they finished 13th out of 15 teams and placing tenth out of 12 teams at the Country Club of Louisiana Intercollegiate. Junior Barry Dyche, who was tied for the lead after the second round, finished tied for 14th at the Intercollegiate.

The Seminoles began the Spring season by placing eighth at the Gator Invitational. The team was once again led by Jason Pool's three round score of 211 which tied him for 11th. The invitational also marked the return of George McNeill who had to sit out the fall season. McNeill finished tied 20th with four golfers.

The finest moment for the Seminoles came at the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championship in Jacksonville. The men finished first out of the 19 teams seven strokes ahead of second place Mississippi State. The tribe had four players finish in the top twenty. Jason Pool, sophomore Steve Carrington and freshmen Nathan Bretsch all finished tied for seventh place. Also, George McNeill tied for 18th.

The following tournament at the Bridges All-American was no let down for the team as they finished fifth out of 20 teams participating. The team was led by Steve Carrington who finished tied for 12th and George McNeill who tied for 17th.

Next, the team returned to Tallahassee for the three-round Seminole Golf Classic. The Seminoles started slow shooting an opening round 304 which placed them at 13th. However, they were able to rebound in the later rounds to finish tied for sixth place with Louisiana State University. Top finishers were Barry Dyche at fifth place and Senior Tice Vieira who finished 19th .

The Seminoles put together another strong showing at the Alabama Spring Invitational placing fifth in the 18 team field. They were led by freshman Nathan Bertsch who tied for 20th.

The Seminoles ended the regular season by finishing ninth in the Cleveland Classic and eighth at the Billy Hitchcock Invitational in preparation for the postseason. Steve Carrington posted the highest finish by a Seminole in these two tournaments tying for 13th at the Billy Hitchcock Invitational with a three round score of 219.

The team concluded their season at the ACC tournament by finishing in fifth place. The team was lead from start to finish by junior George McNeill who shot a three round total of 220 to tie for eighth with two others.

With many key veteran players returning the Seminoles look forward toward moving to the top of the ACC and once again returning to the NCAA championships next spring.


