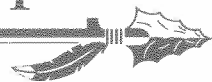

ACKLEY LEADS SEMINOLE MEN'S GOLF TEAM TO NINTH PLACE FINISH AT GARY KOCH

TAMPA, Fla. – Florida State junior Matt Ackley shot a career-low tying two-under par 70 in the third round and the Seminoles finished in ninth place in the team standings at the Gary Koch/Cleveland Golf Intercollegiate as play concluded Tuesday. Ackley led the Seminoles with a 32nd place finish in the individual standings. It was his highest since finishing in 27th place in the 1999 Louisiana State Invitational. A trio of Florida State golfers followed Ackley – Brad Lusenhop, Peter Mitchell and Eric Beaty – who all finished tied for 42nd-place.

Ackley (Lake Mary, Fla.) enjoyed his best round of the tournament after posting consecutive scores of 76 in the first two rounds. His 54-hole total of 222 was the second best of his career. Ackley shot a career-best 219 at the 1999 Billy Hitchcock Intercollegiate. He entered this week's tournament averaging 76.66 strokes in 18 previous career rounds and averaged 74.00 strokes in the three rounds over the course of the last two days.

Junior Pete Mitchell (Miami, Fla.) shot a career-low 71 in the third round and finished in a tie for 42nd-place with a score of 224. His tournament score of 224 marked the best of his career and his finish in the individual standings was the second best of his career. Mitchell stood in a tie for 64th-place in the individual standings after the first round of play and averaged 72.50 strokes in rounds two and three to improve his placement by 22 positions.

Sophomore Brad Lusenhop (Gloversville, N.Y.) and freshman Eric Beaty (Germantown, Tenn.) finished tied for 42nd-place along with Mitchell. Lusenhop shot a two-over par 74 while Beaty carded a five-over par 77 in the third round. Both Lusenhop and Beaty shot even-par scores of 72 in Monday's second round.

Florida's Camilo Villegas sank a 20-foot putt on the final hole to claim individual medallist honors in leading Florida to the team championship. It marked the second consecutive year the Gators had won the event. Florida finished the three-round event with an 843 total, 16 strokes ahead of North Florida and Texas Christian which both tied for second place at 869. The victory was the second of Villegas' collegiate career.

The Seminole men continue their fall schedule at the Tennessee Tournament of Champions in Knoxville, Tenn., Oct. 22-23.

GATORS WIN SECOND CONSECUTIVE GARY KOCH INTERCOLLEGIATE, VILLEGAS WINS MEDALIST HONORS

TAMPA, Fla. – Camilo Villegas sank a 20-foot putt on the final hole to claim individual medalist honors in leading defending national champion Florida to its second consecutive Gary Koch/Cleveland Golf Men's Intercollegiate team title Tuesday. Florida finished the three-round event with an 843 total, 16 strokes ahead of North Florida and TCU which both tied for second place at 869.

On the 18th hole, Villegas sank his 20-foot putt down a hill to win the event. He finished with a 9-under par (207), edging Gator junior Bubba Dickerson by one stroke. Dickerson, who trailed Villegas by four strokes after the first two rounds, placed second at 8-under (208).

"It was a nice battle with Camilo and Bubba," Florida head coach Buddy Alexander said. "You don't want either one lose but it was fun to watch and great to see. It's great to see both of them playing this well this early in the season. Camilo made a great putt to win today. It was not an easy putt by any means."

Villegas built his lead Monday as he shot a competitive course record 62 in the event's second round for a nine-under-par 135. Villegas, who birdied 10 holes and parred the eight other, shattered the former course record of 64 held by professional tour member Spider Miller. The record is "competitive" because tournament co-sponsor Gary Koch shot a 66 from the pro tees on multiple occasions with club members. Villegas' round was shot under tournament conditions on the par-72 course.

In addition, Villegas' 62 was the lowest round shot by a Gator since 1999 when Steve Scott fired a 63 in the Gator Invitational. According to records, it was also the second lowest round registered in school history. The Florida record-low round is 61 shot three times (Billy Turner in 1957; Adam Armagost in 1981; Brian Gay in 1994) but it was accomplished on the University of Florida's par-70 course. The win was the second of his collegiate career (he also won last year's NCAA regional title).

"Camilo didn't have a great first round," Alexander said. "He did the same thing in the first couple of tournaments. He played poorly, then got in the zone in the second round."

All five Gator golfers placed within the field's top-15. Junior Ari Savolainen finished in a tie for seventh (76-70-68-214) and junior Dalton Melynk, competing

in his first collegiate invitational, finished in a tie for 13th place (73-72-73-218). Senior Camilo Benedetti rounded out the Gator lineup in a tie for 15th with a 76-74-79-219. Competing as an individual, junior Robert Litsey tied for 11th place with a 76-69-72-217.

"We needed to play a good event," Buddy Alexander said. "We didn't play as well as we wanted to in our first two tournaments. We didn't play a good first round but our last two rounds, we played just about as well as we could play."

Florida (292-273-278-565) began the second round in third place after shooting a 292, but the Gators used Villegas' 62 and Dickerson's 69 to take command. Kentucky led the field after the first round as it shot a combined 289 (+1), followed by Ohio State (290, +2). After round two, Kentucky trailed the Gators by 14 strokes.

The field featured three of Golfweek's top-10 nationally ranked teams, five of the top-30 nationally ranked teams (1. TCU, 8. Ohio State, 10. Florida, 17. College of Charleston, and 30. North Florida) and nine of the nation's top-50 ranked individuals including UF's Villegas (No. 10) and Dickerson (No. 13).

Florida has now won two straight Gary Koch Intercollegiate titles. In its third year, the Gary Koch/Cleveland Golf Intercollegiate was co-hosted by the University of Florida and the University of Central Florida and was being held in honor of former University of Florida golfer Gary Koch. Koch, who was on hand at the tournament, is a member of the Gators' 1973 NCAA championship team, captured 10 collegiate tournament titles and was a four-time All America selection as a Gator letterwinner from 1971-73.

After graduation, Koch made an impact on the PGA Tour as he won six events and his earnings totaled over \$1 million. In 1990, Koch embarked on a career in broadcast as a golf analyst for ESPN before going to NBC-TV in 1997.

The Old Memorial Golf Course is a par-72, 7,236-yard course. Last year, Florida won the event with a 6-under par three-round total of 858 as 2001 NCAA medalist Nick Gilliam led the Gators with a second-place individual finish.

FRESHMAN BEATY LEADS SEMINOLE MEN'S GOLF TEAM AT GARY KOCH INTERCOLLEGIATE

TAMPA, Fla. – Florida State University freshman Eric Beaty shot an even-par 72 in Monday's second round and moved into a tie for 19th place in the individual standings after the second round of the Gary Koch/Cleveland Golf Intercollegiate at the Old Memorial Golf Course. Beatty lead a Seminole charge in the second round as he and junior Brad Lusenhop shot matching scores of 72 as Florida State moved into a tie for ninth place in the team standings.

Beaty, who is in the Seminoles' starting lineup for the third time during his just-beginning career, shot an even par 72 in round two after carding a three-over par 75 in the first round. He has shot 75 or better in six of his eight rounds this fall. He begins the third round of play in 19th place and is only 12 strokes off the pace set by Camilo Villegas of Florida.

Junior Brad Lusenhop also played well in round two as he matched Beatty with an even-par 72. After an uncharacteristic five-over par 77 in the first round, Lusenhop gained 19 spots in the individual standings and begins round three in a tie for 38th place.

Junior Matt Ackley, who is competing in his first tournament since the spring of 2000, shook off the rust and played well in both rounds. He was the third highest ranking Seminole following the second round after shooting a pair of four-over par 76's.

The Seminoles, who were in a tie for 12th-place in the team standings following the first round, shot a season-best team round of 294 and moved up three spots during the second round.

Villegas shot a competitive course record 62 in the second round to lead Florida to the top of the team standings heading into the third round. He birdied 10 holes and parred the other eight en route to his course record score. Florida shot a two-round total of 565 and leads second place Kentucky by 14 strokes. No. 1 ranked Texas Christian is in third place, 15 stokes behind the Gators.

The tournament concludes Tuesday with a third and final round of 18 holes.

GATOR GOLFER SETS COURSE RECORD, FLORIDA LEADS KENTUCKY BY
14 STROKES AT GARY KOCH/CLEVELAND GOLF INTERCOLLEGIATE

TAMPA, Fla. -- Sophomore Camilo Villegas shot a competitive course record 62 in leading defending national champion and 10th ranked Florida to a first place lead after day one at the third annual Gary Koch/Cleveland Golf Men's Intercollegiate Monday at Old Memorial Golf Course. Florida shot a two-round 565 and leads second place Kentucky (579) by 14 strokes. No. 1 ranked TCU is in third place at 580. The final round will begin tomorrow at 8 a.m. Florida will tee off at 9:30 a.m.

Villegas shattered the former course record of 64 held by professional tour member Spider Miller. The record is competitive because tournament co-sponsor Gary Koch shot a 66 from the pro tees on multiple occasions with club members. Villegas' round was shot under tournament conditions on the par-72 course. In addition, Villegas' 62 was the lowest round shot by a Gator since 1999 when Steve Scott fired a 63 in the Gator Invitational. According to school records, it is also the second lowest round registered in school history. The Florida record-low round is 61 shot three times (Billy Turner in 1957; Adam Armagost in 1981; Brian Gay in 1994) but it was accomplished the University of Florida's par-70 course.

Villegas, a sophomore from Medellin, Columbia, leads the field with a two-round 135. After shooting a first round 73, Villegas birdied 10 holes and parred the other eight en route to his Old Memorial record.

Florida junior Bubba Dickerson, who is playing with a sore shoulder, is currently tied for second place after shooting a 70-69-139. Ohio State's Justin Collins is also tied second after shooting a 68-71-139. Four individuals including TCU's Adam Robinson, North Carolina State's Jason Moon, South Florida's Ricardo Carrillo and North Florida's Brad Schwartz are tied for fourth at 141.

Florida junior Dalton Melynk, who is competing in his first collegiate invitational, is currently tied for 11th place after shooting a 73-72-145, junior Ari Savolainen is tied for 15th with a 76-70-146 and senior Camilo Benedetti is tied for 38th with a 76-74-150. Junior Robert Litsey, competing as an individual, shot a 76-69-145.

Florida (292-273-565) began round two in third place after shooting a 292, but the Gators used Villegas' 62, Dickerson's 69 to take the lead. Kentucky led the field after the first round as it shot a combined 289 (+1), followed by Ohio State

(290, +2). Other local teams competing include South Florida, Central Florida, North Florida.

The field features three of Golfweek's top-10 nationally ranked teams, five of the top-30 nationally ranked teams (1. TCU, 8. Ohio State, 10. Florida, 17. College of Charleston, and 30. North Florida) and nine of the nation's top-50 ranked individuals including Florida's Camilo Villegas (No. 10) and 2001 U.S. Amateur champion Bubba Dickerson (No. 13).

In its third year, the Gary Koch Intercollegiate is hosted by the University of Florida and the University of Central Florida and is being held in honor of former University of Florida golfer Gary Koch. Koch, who is on hand at the tournament, is a member of the Gators' 1973 NCAA championship team, captured 10 collegiate tournament titles and was a four-time All America selection as a Gator letterwinner from 1971-73. After graduation, Koch made an impact on the PGA Tour as he won six events and his earnings totaled over \$1 million. In 1990, Koch embarked on a career in broadcast as a golf analyst for ESPN before going to NBC-TV in 1997.

The Old Memorial Golf Course is a par-72, 7,236-yard course. Last year, Florida won the event with a 6-under par three-round total of 858 as 2001 NCAA medalist Nick Gilliam led the Gators with a second-place finish.
