BEATY LEADS SEMINOLES AT COUNTRY CLUB OF LOUISIANA MEN'S GOLF TOURNAMENT

BATON ROUGE, La. – Freshman Eric Beaty carded two identical rounds of two-over par 74 and is Florida State's top golfer after the first two rounds of the Country Club of Louisiana Intercollegiate. Beaty is one of 40 golfers in the event with scores of four-over par or better and is one of only 34 golfers who shot 74 or better in both of the first two rounds of the tournament. The Seminoles are in 14th-place in the team standings.

Beaty (Germantown, Tenn.) starts round three looking to move up in the individual standings and earn his second top-25 individual finish of the fall season. His previous career-best finish came at the Mason Rudolph Collegiate Championship in September. Beaty's 148 score for the first 54 holes is the third-best of his now five tournament collegiate career. His best two-round score is a 140 during the Mason Rudolph.

Sophomores Brad Lusenhop (Gloversville, N.Y.) and Alan Beers (Midlothian, Va.) are tied for 61st-place with identical scores of 151. Both players shot 74 in the first round and 77 in the second round.

Alabama-Birmingham leads the tournament with a nine-under par team score of 567. Graeme McDowell of UAB is tied with Lee Williams of Auburn for medallist honors heading into Tuesday's third and final round. Both players are tied with scores of eight-under par 136. Williams established a tournament record as he shot a seven-under par 65 in Monday's first round.

This is the final event of the fall season for the Seminoles.

SEMINOLES CLOSE OUT FALL GOLF SEASON AT COUNTRY CLUB OF LOUISIANA INTERCOLLEGIATE

BATON ROUGE, La. – Florida State University sophomore Alan Beers carded a two-over par 74 to move up six positions in the individual standings and lead the Florida State men's golf team as play in the Country Club of Louisiana Intercollegiate concluded Tuesday. Beers finished the event in a tie for 55th-place while teammate Eric Beaty finished in a tie for 51st-place after firing a four-over par 76 in the final round.

Beers (Midlothian, Va.) and Beaty (Germantown, Tenn.) finished the event within one stroke of each other in the individual standings. Both players carded two rounds of 74 and Beaty claimed medallist honors among the Seminoles with a 76 in the third round. He defeated Beers, who shot a 77 in Monday's second round, by one stroke.

Junior Matt Ackley (Lake Mary, Fla.) played his best golf of the tournament as he carded a three-over par 75 in the third round. His play improved throughout the event as he went from an 81 in round one to a 79 in round two to his final round 75. Ackley carded scores of 75 or under in four of his nine rounds this fall.

Alabama-Birmingham won the event in thrilling fashion. The Blazers moved past Mississippi on the final hole of the event when the Rebels dropped four strokes to par the hole and drop to third place in the final standings. Graeme McDowell won the event with a three round score of 204.

The CCLA was the final event of the fall season for the Seminoles. Florida State begins play in the spring season as it travels to play in the Gator Invitational, Feb. 9-10.

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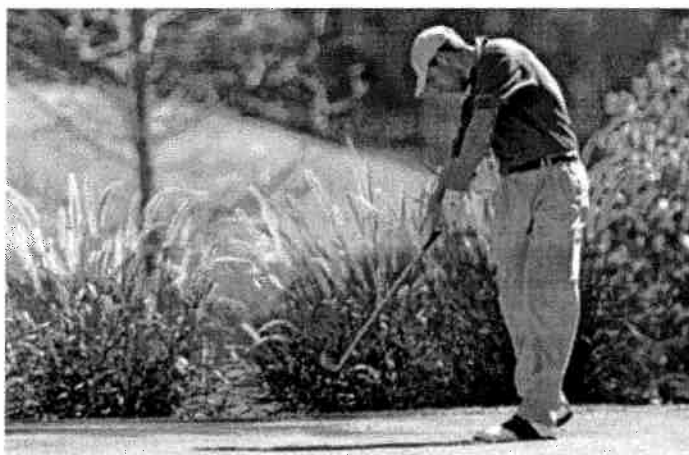

UAB, McDowell Win After Rebel Collapse on 18; LSU Fifth

BATON ROUGE -- The Ole Miss Rebels dropped four strokes to par on the 54th hole of the tournament to fall to third place, giving the UAB Blazers the 2001 Country Club Intercollegiate title in thrilling fashion on Tuesday in Baton Rouge.

The Rebels counted a birdie, a par, and double and triple bogeys on the 18th hole to fall from 10-under-par to 6 UAB won the tournament by shooting 8-under 856, one stroke better than Auburn which finished at 7-under 85

The tournament host, the LSU Tigers, tied for the day's third-lowest round with a 1-under 287 to finish in fifth place under 862 for the three-round event. North Florida was ahead of the Tigers in fourth at 5-under 859.

Individually, UAB's Graeme McDowell, who tied for seventh in last season's CCLA, took medalist honors by shooting 12-under 204 and setting the tournament record by two strokes. On Tuesday, McDowell completed the tournament a 4-under 204. The previous record was set last season by Alan Moran of LSU, who shot 10-under 206 to take honors during his senior season.

McDowell beat out Auburn's Lee Williams (9-under 207) and three golfers at 8-under 206 including Ole Miss' Adam Medley the Ole Miss Rebel who triple bogeyed the 18th.
