FLORIDA STATE MEN'S GOLF TEAM FINISHES IN 6^{TH} PLACE AT ATLANTIC COAST CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP; MITCHELL EARNS NINTH PLACE INDIVIDUAL FINISH

UWHARRIE PT., N.C. – The Florida State University men's golf team finished in sixth place in the team standings at the 49th annual Atlantic Coast Conference championship – its best team finish since coming in fifth in 1995. Junior Peter Mitchell finished in a tie for ninth place in the team standings as he finished the event with a career-best 211 score for the 54-hole event.

Florida State finished the tournament with three of its top seven single round team scores this season including a season-best 282 in the second round. The Seminoles three-round total of 868 was their best at the ACC championship since totaling an 866 in 1988 and was 29 strokes better than their team score during last year's tournament when the finished in eighth place. In addition, the Seminoles two-spot improvement in the team standings in the best of any of the nine ACC teams from last season to this season.

Mitchell, who has finished in the top 15 of three of his last four tournaments, completed the best tournament of his career. He tied his career-low score for a single round with identical scores of 70 in rounds one and two; completed his top 36-hole (140) and 54-hole (211) scores and finished a career-best five-under par for the tournament. Mitchell (Miami, Fla.) is a combined four-under par over the last two tournaments and has shot five of his last six rounds at 72 or below.

Freshman Eric Beaty (Germantown, Tenn.), who shot his tournament-best 69 in round two, came on strong in the final two rounds of the tournament and finished in a tie for 23rd place. He finished tied with teammate Rick Westbrook (Alto, Ga.) who carded a two-under par 70 in round one an even par 72 in round two.

Florida State closes out its season as it plays in the Atlanta Intercollegiate in Stockbridge, Ga., May 9-10.

NEW LONDON, N.C. — Georgia Tech closed with a flourish here today to successfully defend its Atlantic Coast Conference men's golf championship with a four-shot margin over surprising North Carolina State, and North Carolina's Dustin Bray held on to take the individual crown by two strokes

The Yellow Jackets who led wire-to-wire over the 54-hole event had to pull out all the stops down the stretch to capture their eighth tem title since becoming a member of the ACC in 1979. This was Georgia Tech's third championship over the past four years.

Tech had a five-shot lead over Clemson going into today's final round, but found itself in a tight battle with N.C. State and Clemson going into the closing stages. At one point, with just two holes to play, the Wolfpack had a one-shot lead and Georgia Tech and Clemson were tied.

On the final hole, the tough par-five, 568-yard dogleg left, the five Tech players finished with two pars, one birdie and two eagles. After Kris Mikkelsen made the birdie, Matt Weibring and freshman Nicholas Thompson posted back-to-back eagles to decide the championship.

Georgia Tech finished 27 strokes under par at 837 while N.C. State, which had the day's best score at 274, finished 23 shots under par at 841. Clemson finished third at 845 and Wake Forest fourth at 851. North Carolina was sixth at 862 followed by Florida State at 868, Virginia at 874, Maryland at 875 and Duke at 878.

"The great thing about these guys is that they were able to hang and hang even though N.C. State ran at them all day," Georgia Tech Coach Bruce Heppler said after the championship was decided.

Bray, the Tar Heel sophomore from Asheboro who had a three-shot lead after posting rounds of 66-67 the first two days finished up with an even par round to finished at 11 under par 205. He had only one birdie today after getting 13 birdies the first two days.

Weibring and Thompson tied for second in the individual chase with 207's. Garth Mulroy of N.C. State and Bill Haas of Wake Forest tied for fifth at 208. Mulroy and Wake Forest's Jay Morgan had the day's lowest rounds of 67.

Nineteen of the 45 players finished under par for the 54-hole championship.


