FLORIDA STATE MEN'S GOLF TEAM CONCLUDES SEASON WITH 11TH PLACE FINISH AT ATLANTA INTERCOLLEGIATE; MOSLEY LEADS SEMINOLES IN INDIVIDUAL STANDINGS

STOCKBRIDGE, Ga. – The Florida State men's golf team finished in 11th place at the Atlanta Intercollegiate with sophomore Rusty Mosley finishing as the highest ranking Seminole in a tie for 28th place. The event was the final tournament of the season for the Seminoles who earned five top-10 team finishes in seven tournaments this spring.

Mosley (Vidalia, Ga.) finished the event with a 220 score for the three round event. His 54-hole score tied his best tournament score of the 2003 spring season and was tied for his third best of the 2002-03 fall and spring seasons combined. Mosley was at even par after the first two rounds of the event and finished as the Seminoles' leading golfer in for the fifth time this season.

Sophomore Matt Adcock (Apopka, Fla.) led the Seminoles in the third round with a four-over par score of 75. He finished with a 54-hole score of 223 – his second best of the spring and fourth best for the entire 2002-03 season. Adcock finished the season as the Seminoles' leading golfer with a 74.40 stroke average in 20 rounds during seven tournaments.

Junior Tim Vickers (Alpharetta, Ga.), sophomore Mark Sestilio (Punta Gorda, Fla.) and freshman Adam Wallace (Ponte Vedra Beach, Fla.) also competed for the Seminoles.

Panthers finish fourth at Atlanta Intercollegiate

STOCKBRIDGE, Ga.- Shooting a tournament record team score of 828, SEC Champion Florida captured the Atlanta Intercollegiate title Friday. Florida was led by junior Camilo Villegas who shot an unreachable 22-under par 194, edging the previous top individual score of 197.

Georgia State struggled in the final round, but finished in fourth-place with 854 helped by a school record round of 276 in the first day of play. The team passed by fourth-ranked nationally Augusta State (5th place), 11th-ranked Auburn (7th place) and 12th-ranked Georgia (6th place).

Junior Kasper Jorgenson continues to lead the team with his seventh top-10 finish of the season, placing sixth among the 66 golfers with 211.

In a distant second behind tournament winner Florida, Clemson (#1 in the country) shot an 848 with rounds of 288, 279 and 281. The College of Charleston finished third with 849, five strokes ahead of host Georgia State. Augusta State rounded out the top five teams with 855.

Camilo Villegas shot a 10-under par 62 in the final round to seal the victory after consistent rounds of 66 and 66. His individual score of 194 was the lowest in the history of the Atlanta Intercollegiate, three strokes ahead of 2002 champion Graeme McDowell of UAB. The College of Charleston's Bruce McDonald tied with Clemson's Jack Ferguson (#7 in the country) for second place (208). Fourth-place belonged to Clemson's Matt Hendrix (209), followed by the College of Charleston's Kyle Bradley (210).

Kasper Jorgenson fell to sixth-place after a 3-over par 75 in the final round (211). Junior T.J. Washburn picked up his first top-10 finish with a 212, good for ninth-place. Sophomore Ty Harris carded a 215 to place 17th, followed by Jonathan Fricke in 25th place with 219. Freshman golfers Darren Baynes (222) and Derek Oakey (228) placed 36th and 50th, respectively.

Armed with experience gained from competing at the Atlanta Intercollegiate against eight teams bound for postseason play, Coach Trey Jones and the Panthers will head to Auburn, Ala. next week to compete at the NCAA East Regional.

The field will feature 27 teams and six individuals, with only the top ten teams and two individuals advancing on the NCAA Championship finals. Regional competition begins May 15.

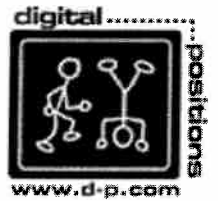
