SEMINOLES' ADCOCK EARNS TOP FIVE FINISH TO LEAD SEMINOLE MEN'S GOLF TEAM TO SEVENTH PLACE FINISH AT CLEVELAND GOLF/KIAWAH ISLAND INTERCOLLEGIATE

KIAWAH ISLAND, S.C. – Junior Matt Adcock shot a career-low 68 in the second round and finished in a career-best tie for fifth place in the individual standings to lead the Florida State men's golf team to a seventh place finish at the Cleveland Gold/Kiawah Island Intercollegiate at Turtle Point Golf Course. The event was shortened from three rounds to two after torrential rain forced the field to play only one round Monday.

John Holmes of Kentucky fired a 68 to help Kentucky to the team championship as the Wildcats outdistanced Georgia State by three strokes. The Seminoles finished second among three Atlantic Coast Conference teams in the event – three strokes behind Virginia and three strokes ahead of Maryland. Aron Price of Georgia Southern claimed individual medalist honors with a nine-under par score of 135. He finished seven strokes in front of Adcock.

Adcock (Apopka, Fla.) improved his standing by 18 positions as he carded a career-best 68 in Tuesday's second round. His 142 score for 36-holes also ranks as her career best as does his tie for fifth place finish in the individual standings. Adcock's previous best single round score of 69 came during the Mason Rudolph Championship during the fall of 2002 while his previous best finish of 11th came at the Seminole Intercollegiate during the spring of 2003.

Junior Mark Sestilio (Punta Gorda, Fla.) gained his first career top-10 finish as he carded a one-over par 73 in the second round to finish with an even par score of 144 for the two-round event. Sestilio had never finished higher than 20th place during his previous six tournaments as a Seminole.

Junior Rusty Mosley (Vidalia, Ga.) carded a one-over par 73 in the second round to finish with a 152 total. He finished in a tie for 36th place in the individual standings. Seminole senior Tim Vickers (Alpharetta, Ga.) and Gonzalo Ibarraran (Coahuila, Mexico) carded a personal tournament best 77 in the second round.

The event was the first for the Seminoles under head coach Trey Jones who was named the Head Men's Golf Coach and Director of Golf Operations at Florida State in July. The Seminoles continue their fall schedule as travel to the Mason Rudolph Championship Sept. 15-16 in Nashville, Tenn.

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Wildcats Claim Kiawah Intercollegiate, Defending Champion Cougars Take 8th From: CofC Media Relations

Kiawah Island, SC – John Holmes fired a final round 68 to help Kentucky claim the Kiawah Intercollegiate championship bettering Georgia Southern by three shots. Georgia Southern finished four shots back of the Wildcats at 580 for the rain shortened two round tournament. The two-time defending champion College of Charleston finished tied for eighth in the event.

Aaron Price followed up his course record 65 yesterday with a two under par 70 today to win the individual medalist from Georgia State. Kentucky placed two players in the top four with Holmes placing second and Mark Blakefield coming in tied for third at 141. Adam Grodhaus led the way for the Cougars shooting a 70 today and totaling 147 for the Invitational, which gave him a tie for 17th place.

Kentucky came into the day six shots off of first round leader Mississippi but scores of 68, 70, 71, and 73 from the Wildcats top four led them to victory. Florida State's Matt Adock tied Holmes for lowest round of the day firing a 68 in today's much improved weather.

The Cougars led by Grodhaus' 70 today fired a second round 297 and finished the weekend at 598. John Assey and Wesley Carter posted rounds of 74 for the Cougars and Kellen Altman tallied a 79.

The shot of the tournament came off the club by Colt Knost when he aced the par 3 189 yard seventh hole. Knost earned the hole-in-one with a six iron en route to a front nine 35 and a 72 for the day. He finished tied for eighth overall for the weekend at 143.
