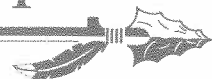

### MOSLEY TOPS SEMINOLES AS PLAY AT ATLANTA INTERCOLLEGIATE MEN'S GOLF TOURNAMENT IS COMPLETED

STOCKBRIDGE, Ga. – Junior Rusty Mosley finished in a tie for 18<sup>th</sup> place in the individual standings and the Florida State men's golf team finished 10<sup>th</sup> in the team standings as play in the 54-hole Atlanta Intercollegiate at Eagle's Landing Country Club came to a close Tuesday. Mosley carded an even par 72 and finished the tournament with a one-under par 216 to mark the first time in his collegiate career he had finished an event under par.

Mosley (Vidalia, Ga.) came within four strokes of tying his career-low score for a tournament as he carded two of three rounds during the event at par or better. He finished the tournament two-under over the final 36-holes after carding a one-over par 73 in the first round. Mosley's best tournament score of his career – a one-over par 211 – came at the Mason Rudolph Collegiate Championship in the fall of 2002.

Freshman Bradley Ruch (Lexington, Ken.) continued his stellar play of late as he carded a one-under par 71 in the final round. Coupled with his three-under par 69 in the second round, Ruch played the final two rounds at a four-under par score of 140. His second round score of 69 is a career-low while his 219 tournament score is only one stroke off of his career-best 218 at the spring 2004 Gator Invitational. Ruch finished in a tie for 31<sup>st</sup> place in the individual standings.

Junior Matt Adcock (Apopka, Fla.) completed a trifecta with three identical scores of 75 and finished in a tie for 45<sup>th</sup> place in the individual standings. Mark Sestilio (Punta Gorda, Fla.) also finished with three identical scores of 76 and a three-round total of 228. Junior Alan Beers (Warner Robbins, Ga.) also competed in the event for the Seminoles.

Florida won the tournament title for the second consecutive year with a score of 839. Florida's Camilo Villegas earned individual medalist honors for the second year in a row after firing 204.

Florida State will be back in action at the Billy Hitchcock Intercollegiate April 9-11 in Auburn, Ala. The tournament will be held at the Saugahatchee Country Club and is hosted by Auburn University.

### Georgia State finishes ahead of No. 2 Clemson, No. 3 Georgia and No. 5 Georgia Tech in Atlanta Intercollegiate

Georgia State fired 274 in the final round of the 12-team Atlanta Intercollegiate third with a final score of 854. With the lowest round of the day, the Panthers finished ahead of national powerhouses No. 2 Clemson, No. 3 Georgia, No. 5 Georgia Tech, No. 16 Augusta State. Florida won the tournament title for the second consecutive year with a score of 839. Florida's Camilo Villegas earned individual medalist honors in his second year in a row after firing 204.

"It was extremely exciting to watch my guys shoot the low score by ten strokes in the final day which was a school record. The tournament was a great success. We saw outstanding golf this week," said Georgia State Head Coach Matt Clark. "The Florida players played exceptionally well every day."

No. 1 Florida carded 839 to win the tournament by 14 strokes. No. 12 South Carolina finished second with 853. Georgia State's third place finish was its highest ever at the Atlanta Intercollegiate. Reigning NCAA Champion Clemson was close behind with 851. No. 3 Georgia and No. 5 Georgia Tech were seven strokes behind Clemson and finished fourth and fifth.

All of the Panthers contributed individually for the team's low round score, with Georgia State's golfers finishing in the top 20 of the 64-golfer field. Jonathan Fricke shot his best third round score of his career at 66 for a total score of 208 for third. Seniors Kasper Jorgensen and junior Ty Harris each shot 69 for the day. Jorgensen finished with a total score of 213 and Harris finished 18th with 215. Freshman Ben Taylor fired 70 for his third round and had a three round score of 219 for 31st place. This was also Taylor's best three-round tournament score. Sophomore Darren Baynes carded 228 for 51st place. Freshman Morgan Nix shot 90 for a total of 260 for 64th.

"I'm proud of Jonathan Fricke and Kasper Jorgensen, our two seniors for playing well in their final home tournament," said Clark. "I challenged the guys to go out and shoot the low score in the last round and they did it by ten strokes. I'm thankful I have the opportunity to coach such a great group of young men."

Georgia State will be back in action at the Billy Hitchcock Intercollegiate April 11-13 at Auburn, Ala. The tournament will be held at the Saugahatchee Country Club hosted by Auburn University.
